Bargen, 2006-09-30 On September 13 1912 the day of Emperor Meiji s funeral General Nogi Maresuke committed ritual suicide by seppuku disembowelment It was an act of delayed atonement that paid a debt of honor incurred thirty five years earlier The revered military hero's wife joined in his act of junshi following one's lord into death The violence of their double suicide shocked the nation What had impelled the general and his wife on the threshold of a new

era to resort so drastically so dramatically to this forbidden anachronistic practice.
