Understanding the Impact of Machine Learning on Labor and Education Joseph Ganem, 2023-06-01 This book provides a novel framework for understanding and revising labor markets and education policies in an era of machine learning It posits that while learning and knowing both require thinking learning is fundamentally different than knowing because it results in cognitive processes that change over time Learning in contrast to knowing requires time and agency Therefore learning algorithms that enable machines to modify their actions based on real world experiences are a fundamentally new form of artificial intelligence that have potential to be even more disruptive to labor markets than prior introductions of digital technology To explore the difference between knowing and learning Turing's Imitation Game that he proposed as a test for machine thinking is expanded to include time dependence The arguments presented in the book introduce three novel
