They used resemblance as a heuristic rule of thumb to simplify things when making a difficult judgment. Relying on this heuristic caused predictable biases (systematic errors) in their predictions. The research partners learned that people tend to determine the importance of issues by how easy they are retrieved from their memory. This is brought about in large part by the extent of coverage of the issues in the media. Kahneman presents a view of how the mind works drawing on recent developments in cognitive and social psychology. He explains the differences between fast intuitive thinking and slow deliberate thinking.
