What is Gilbert's Syndrome

Gilbert's syndrome is the name for elevated bilirubin levels due to genetic reasons when other liver tests are normal.

When hemoglobin is broken down, it creates a metabolite called biliverdin, which is then transformed into bilirubin. In order to be excreted easily by the body, bilirubin is conjugated with glucuronic acid.

Genetics

The UGT1A1 gene is central to bilirubin conjugation. UGT1A1 is an enzyme that catalyzes the reaction driving the conjugation of bilirubin with glucuronic acid.

Variants that decrease UGT1A1 activity cause Gilbert's Syndrome. Increase UGT1A1 with cruciferous vegetables (broccoli, cabbage, kale, Brussels sprouts).
