This thesis is supported by an examination of the structural and literary parallels in the historical records after identifying five major theological themes as having their basis in Genesis 1-7. Gage then traces them through Scripture showing that the eschatology of the Bible is intimately bound up with the protology of the early chapters of Genesis.
