

was driven ever further underground He also allocated resources to fortifications and counterattacks like the V missile installations against both West and East in attempts to stave off defeat Convicted as a war criminal at Nuremberg Speer served twenty years at Spandau Prison and remained a Nazi apologist who died in London in 1981 on the anniversary of the German invasion of Poland Together Todt and Speer were the pillars that propped up the Third Reich through the vicissitudes of battlefield fortune With over three hundred photographs this is the first work that examines their role in history s most terrible war
