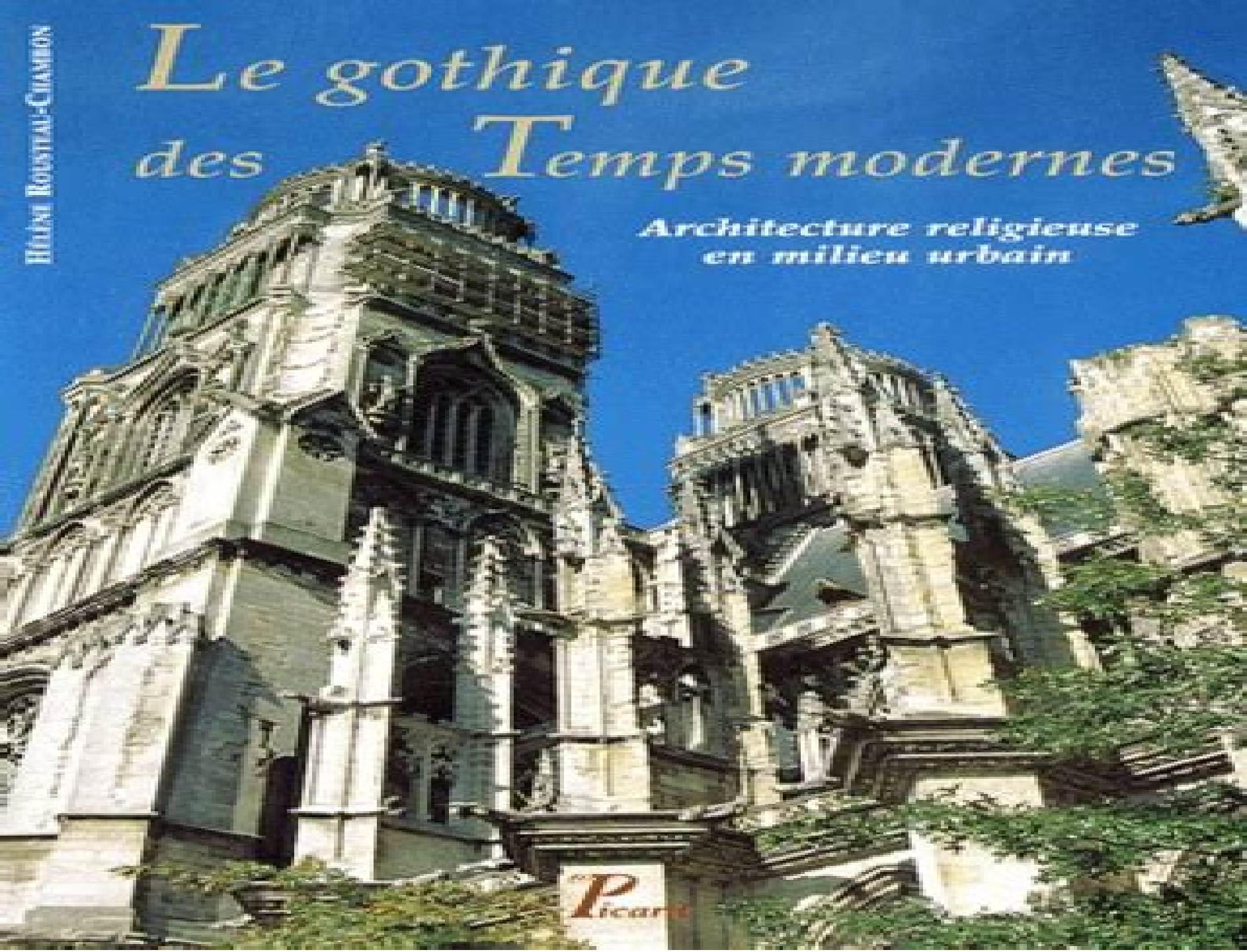

They too occasionally misinterpreted younger buildings as proofs of majestic Roman or other ancient glory such as the buildings of the Carolingian Ottonian and Stauffer emperors. But even if the correct age of a certain building was known buildings from c 800-1200 were sometimes regarded as Antique architecture since the concept of Antiquity was far more stretched than our modern periodisation allows.
