Examining stone vessels in the Levant during the 2nd millennium BC the author explores the links between material culture and society through a comprehensive study of production and distribution Extensively illustrated with 100 drawings maps and charts this volume includes a full object catalogue This study represents the first comprehensive overview of the stone vessel assemblages of the Levant in this period a time which fed by an increase of wealth and interregional trade saw a growth in the popularity and variety of such vessels Previously our understanding of the varied functions and forms of these diverse vessels has been relatively underdeveloped In this volume the author attempts to address this problem by creating a typological framework through which we can analyse variability and define essential characteristics of local stone vessel workshops Only once this has been achieved is it possible to look at stone vessel production in its wider cultural context Subsequent chapters explore broader themes beginning within the workshops themselves examining the links between craftsmen their sources of raw materials and the authorities that controlled and distributed their output Considerations of the geographical and chronological distribution of such goods are then used to provide a regional perspective for the operation of these workshops connections between them and further insights into the nature of local and international trade Finally the objects themselves can be used to assess the impact of trends such as the growing Egyptianization of the ruling classes of the Levant at this time

**The Tomb of Three Foreign Wives of Tuthmosis III** Christine Lilyquist, 2003 This book results from a collaborative effort to reconstruct the 15th century BC tomb of three foreign wives of Tuthmosis III discovered and robbed by villagers near Luxor in 1916 A general account was published by Herbert Winlock in 1948 *The Treasure of Three Egyptian Princesses* New York The Metropolitan Museum of Art The present volume differs substantially in the type and extent of documentation provided and in interpretation Verification is provided of tomb provenance for a number of objects for example while other objects previously thought to have come from the tomb are now considered forgeries The text explores and documents the location of the tomb in the southwest valleys at Thebes field work conducted by The Metropolitan Museum of Art at the site in 1988 art market finds alleged to have come from the tomb and the names of the foreign wives and the life they might have led

The Egyptian Collection at Norwich Castle Museum represents the first full publication of this important collection which contains several outstanding objects Part 1 begins with an outline of the acquisition history of the Egyptian collection and its display within Norwich Castle in 1894 when it was converted from a prison to a museum The collection was largely acquired between the nineteenth and first part of the twentieth centuries Its most prominent donor was Flaxman Spurrell whose varied collection of flints faience beads and necklaces as well as Late Antique cloths was obtained from Sir Flinders Petrie Also prominent was the Norwich based Colman family most notable for its manufacture of mustard whose collection was purchased in Egypt during the late C19 Also included in this part are essays on several of the museum's outstanding items Ipu's shroud a rare early 18th Dynasty example with fragments also held in Cairo the 22nd Dynasty finely decorated and well preserved cartonnage and wooden lid of the priest Ankhhor and the exceptional model granary of Nile clay painted with lively scenes one showing the owner Intef playing senet Part 2 is a detailed catalogue of the complete collection It is organised into sections with objects grouped together mainly according to type stelae shabtis scarabs jewellery amulets vessels flints lamps inscribed Book of the Dead fragments metal figurines and Late Antique cloths and also according to function such as cosmetics grooming and architectural furniture elements The inscribed materials have all been translated and individual entries give examples or parallels Seventy colour plates illustrate each object      *The Political Situation in Egypt During the Second Intermediate Period, c. 1800-1550 B.C.* K. S. B. Ryholt, Adam Bülow-Jacobsen, 1997 The Second Intermediate Period designates the 250 year period 1800-1550 BC which separates the two glorious periods of the Middle Kingdom and the New Kingdom During the 19th century BC an invasion by Canaanite tribes into the Delta took place Around 1800 BC these people proclaimed their own king and the Delta thus became independent from the rest of Egypt Egypt remained split between the Canaanitic rulers in North and the native Egyptian Kings in the South for the rest of the Second Intermediate Period The division of Egypt brought about an economic decline and the entire period is characterized by a lack of royal monuments This circumstance has greatly hampered any attempts to establish a chronology of the period and as a consequence it has been very difficult to date many sources which are relevant for the social and political situation of the period The Second Intermediate Period has therefore remained one of the most obscure periods of Egypt's ancient history The dissertation is a new attempt to establish a chronology for the Second Intermediate Period and define the different kingdoms their territories and political relations The study consists of four main chapters three appendixes a catalogue of sources bibliography and indices Included is a catalogue of all the historical sources about 1500 known to certify the names of the Egyptian kings of the Second Intermediate Period Each source is described in terms of type origin and present location

Graff, Yelena Rakic, 2013 The exhibition Beyond Babylon Art Trade and Diplomacy in the Second Millennium B C held in 2008 2009 at The Metropolitan Museum of Art demonstrated the cultural enrichment that emerged from the intensive interaction of civilizations from western Asia to Egypt and the Aegean in the Middle and Late Bronze Ages During this critical period in human history powerful kingdoms and large territorial states were formed Rising social elites created a demand for copper and tin as well as for precious gold and silver and exotic materials such as lapis lazuli and ivory to create elite objects fashioned in styles that reflected contacts with foreign lands This quest for metals along with the desire for foreign textiles was the driving force that led to the establishment of merchant colonies and a vast trading network throughout central Anatolia during the early second millennium B C Texts from palaces at sites from Hattusa modern Bogazk y in Hittite Anatolia to Amarna in Egypt attest to the volume and variety of interactions that took place some centuries later creating the impetus for the circulation of precious goods stimulating the exchange of ideas and inspiring artistic creativity Perhaps the most dramatic evidence for these far flung connections emerges out of tragedy the wreckage of the oldest known seagoing ship discovered in a treacherous stretch off the southern coast of Turkey near the promontory known as Uluburun Among its extraordinary cargo of copper glass and exotic raw materials and luxury goods is a gilded bronze statuette of a goddess perhaps the patron deity on board who failed in her mission to protect the ship To explore the themes of the exhibition art trade and diplomacy viewed from an international perspective a two day symposium and related scholarly events allowed colleagues to explore many facets of the multicultural societies that developed in the second millennium B C Their insights which dramatically illustrate the incipient phases of our intensely interactive world are presented largely in symposium order beginning with broad regional overviews and examination of particular archeological contexts and then drawing attention to specific artists and literary evidence for interconnections In this introduction however their contributions are viewed from a somewhat more synthetic perspective one that focuses attention on the ways in which
