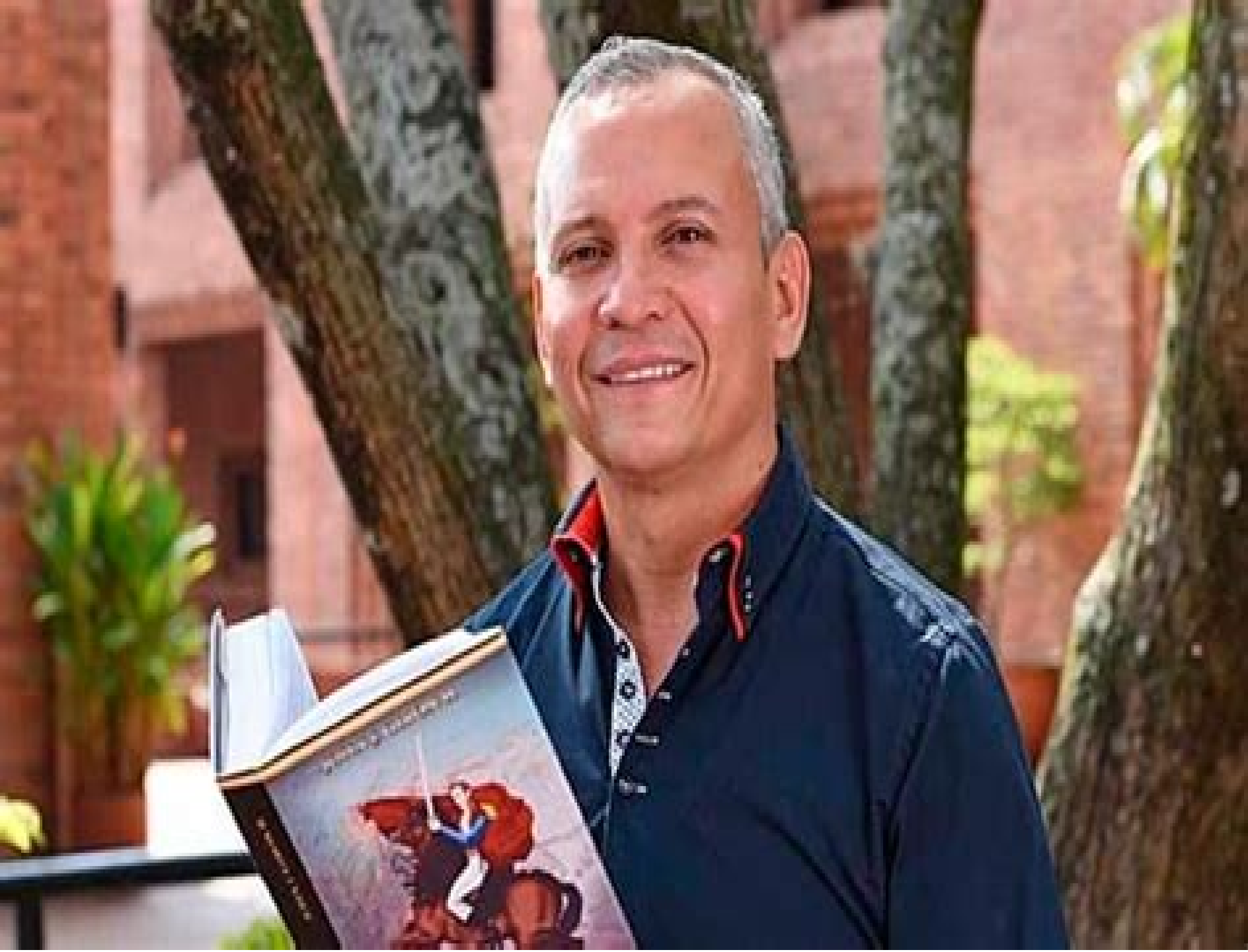

Índice informativo de la novela hispanoamericana Edna Coll, 1974 Dr Edna Coll is known in the Latin American literary world for having consecrated more than twenty years to unravel the sense of fiction creation in Spanish speaking America and to organize this sense in synthesis and perspectives which surpass the nations where each one of these authors write *Novelas breves* Juan Carlos Onetti, Prólogo de Juan José Saer, 2021-12-01 Y si elijo el sueño de la cabaña de troncos no es porque tenga alguna razón especial Hay otras aventuras más completas más interesantes mejor ordenadas Pero me quedo con la de la cabaña porque me obligar a contar un prólogo algo que me sucedió en el mundo de los hechos reales hace unos cuarenta años También podría ser un plan el ir contando un suceso y un sueño Todos quedaríamos contentos En los sesenta se alía Juan José Saer en su prólogo la novela breve se constituye en la máxima aspiración estética de los narradores jóvenes Por un lado su extensión tenía la ventaja de permitir muchas opciones constructivas Por otro los atributos propiamente poéticos y retóricos como el ritmo el cuidado verbal el laconismo la sugestión en contraposición a la discursividad el prosaísmo las convenciones estructurales y el conceptualismo de la novela estimulaban especialmente la imaginación Onetti considerado uno de los escritores modernos más originales utilizó todos los elementos del relato de manera novedosa y compleja Y las siete novelas que conforman este volumen *El Pozo Los adioses Para una tumba sin nombre La cara de la desgracia Jacob y el otro Tan triste como ella y La muerte y la vida* sin dudas confirman esa unicidad y vida que justifica a toda obra de arte que menciona Saer Pero estas novelas ofrecen además un recorrido intenso por los temas predilectos de Onetti la desgracia y la crueldad la resignación y el fracaso la rabia y la autodestrucción pero también el amor la culpa la nostalgia a veces la esperanza y sobre todo la compasión **La invención de la ciencia en América. Propaganda científica en la novela histórica colombiana** Jorge Manuel Escobar Ortiz, 2022-01-10 Este trabajo indaga por las imágenes de la ciencia en una forma particular de discurso histórico la novela histórica colombiana Sus teorías afirman que una de las principales virtudes de este género es su capacidad de ofrecer perspectivas críticas sobre las narrativas dominantes de la historia social política y cultural del país Interesa comprender qué sucede con ese carácter crítico cuando el foco es la ciencia pone a prueba el género las narrativas dominantes de la historiografía científica colombiana o las refuerza y las amplifica La respuesta de este libro es que la novela histórica colombiana no suele asumir una postura crítica con tales narrativas cuando su temática es la ciencia sino que sirve de plataforma para reafirmarlas y propagarlas **El precursor velado** Daniel Balderston, 1985 **Estética de la novela** Luis Beltrán Almería, 2021-02-18 Estética de la novela expone una historia de la novela a través de las diversas estéticas que ha desplegado este género desde su aparición en la Antigüedad hasta la actualidad Partiendo de una concepción del complejo fenómeno novela como puente entre la cultura popular y la cultura elevada se explican esas estéticas como el recorrido del espíritu de la sociedad abierta al despegarse de la tradición sin renunciar a servirse de ella Desde una nueva concepción de los orígenes de la novela la protonovela se recorren las dos orientaciones de la novela premoderna la cortesana

y la popular y la gran fusión que significa la novela moderna para ofrecer un horizonte de igualdad y libertad La mujer en la novela policíaca hispana Myung N. Choi, 2012 Este estudio examina cómo el género influye en las protagonistas femeninas de la novela policíaca hispana escrita por mujeres Analizo las novelas de Lourdes Ortiz y Alicia Giménez Bartlett María Elvira Bermúdez Marcela Serrano y Miriam Laurini para determinar cómo los detectives femeninos difieren de detectives masculinos y cómo difieren uno de otro Al igual que sus homólogos masculinos los detectives investigan los crímenes de mujeres mediante la lógica la ciencia y la psicología La protagonista de la novela que parodia Lourdes Ortiz es el típico *hard boiled* de la novela detectivesca con protagonista masculino lo que demuestra lo absurdo del modelo que imita En las novelas de Giménez Bartlett la detective desafía al hombre y es muchas veces más profesional que sus colegas masculinos especialmente su asistente masculino La detective inteligente de Bermúdez se parece mucho al protagonista masculino de la novela policíaca clásica pero todos los personajes principales de este texto son mujeres Por otro lado la detective de Marcela Serrano combina la empatía y la intuición con el razonamiento deductivo para encontrar a una persona desaparecida Por último Miriam Laurini presenta a su periodista detective quien busca la justicia para las mujeres quienes son víctimas de la delincuencia y la violencia El análisis de la violencia el sexo y el lenguaje en los textos de estas cinco autoras se observa la subversión de la sociedad patriarcal desde diferentes perspectivas

Novelas breves 1 Juan Carlos Onetti, 2016-07-18 Este primer volumen de las novelas cortas de Juan Carlos Onetti reúne *El pozo* 1939 *Los adioses* 1954 *Para una tumba sin nombre* 1959 *La cara de la desgracia* 1960 y *Jacob y el otro* 1961 Con la publicación de *El pozo* en 1939 Juan Carlos Onetti imprimió las primeras huellas de una trayectoria extraordinaria al tiempo que la literatura hispanoamericana abrió sus puertas a una voz irrepetible Este primer volumen de sus *Novelas breves* abarca un periodo de veintidós años a lo largo de los cuales el autor uruguayo consolidó e hizo inconfundible un estilo perpetrado en obras como las que aquí se reúnen *Los adioses* 1954 *Para una tumba sin nombre* 1959 *La cara de la desgracia* 1960 y *Jacob y el otro* 1961 además de su ya mentado debut narrativo Sus páginas son el fruto amargo de la turbia pero hiriente mirada de unos ojos enfrentados al rostro mismo de la existencia y la condición humana Reseñas Onetti sintetiza simultáneamente la precisión constructiva y lingüística de Borges y la pasión humana Para Onetti escribe en el límite del idioma Antonio Muñoz Molina El más grande novelista latinoamericano Julio Cortázar

Cano, 2017-11-15 Los espíritus de la ciencia ficción efectúan un análisis comparativo de tres de las novelas fundacionales de la ciencia ficción hispanoamericana publicadas como folletines en la segunda mitad del siglo XIX: *Viaje maravilloso del señor Nic-Nac al planeta Marte* de Eduardo Ladislao Holmberg (Argentina, 1875), *Desde Júpiter* de Francisco Miralles (Chile, 1877) y *Querens* de Pedro Castera (México, 1890). Además de reunir los atributos que de manera consistente se presentan en un texto de ciencia ficción: imitación o parodia de alguno de los rasgos convencionalmente aceptados como distintivos de un texto científico; evaluación crítica de los discursos y sujetos de la ciencia; reflexión crítica sobre el tiempo como categoría; las tres novelas ponen en narrativa una síntesis de los programas espiritistas desarrollados por Allan Kardec y Nicolas Flammarion con las propuestas darwinianas en boga en su momento. De forma coherente con las inquietudes políticas y las reflexiones intelectuales que definen los programas de desarrollo de las naciones recientemente independizadas, los tres textos intentan concretar una identidad genérica oscilando entre los requisitos editoriales establecidos por la institución periodística: la necesidad de adecuarse a los imperativos de construcción de la idea de nación en los respectivos países y el compromiso de encontrar un balance entre la literatura de elites y la cultura popular. El libro ofrece substanciales contribuciones al discernimiento de las primeras instancias de configuración de la ciencia ficción a través del estudio del folletín en la escritura decimonónica de la interacción entre periodismo y narrativa y de la confluencia entre el ocultismo y la literatura en las letras de Hispanoamérica durante el siglo XIX.

Guzmán de Alfarache y la novela moderna Michel Cavillac, 2010 Reune este libro quince ensayos dedicados al humanismo reformista de Mateo Alemán, intelectual comprometido *avant la lettre* y centrados en la poética subversiva del Guzmán de Alfarache. Desde diversos enfoques textuales, contextuales, intertextuales, estos estudios reivindican el inconformismo y la modernidad tanto ideológica como narrativa de una ficción ataláyista que a la trayectoria vital de una persona ni buena ni mala confiere la universalidad de la condición humana. La relectura de la *Atalaya* que se ofrece aquí obedece a una coherencia nueva: interpretar la patética confesión de Guzmán no desde la certeza de su liberación final sino a la luz de su probable permanencia en las galeras, situación discursiva que induce a revisar no pocas ideas sobre la poética historia del galeote escritor empezando por la mediación creativa del lector interno o extraficcional y la finalidad de las reflexiones morales que se le dirigen. No en balde este discurso va ordenado desde el desenlace de una fábula anclada en el deseo de alcanzar algún tiempo de libertad. En ese sentido, confortado por el conflictivo atalayismo aureo y la preceptiva del Pinciano relativa al fin miserable del poema, la epopeya tragicómica de Guzmán mezcla menipea de estilos a la medida de la compleja psicología del personaje, rebasa con creces los confines del género picaresco. A juzgar por la apasionada recepción de la obra por Quevedo, Cervantes y Gracian, el Guzmán venía a ser un libro rupturista que marcaba un hito decisivo en la historia de la novela realista moderna.
