The author also takes us inside the great imperial mosques, the thronged and colourful bazaars, schoolrooms, palaces and private houses and takes us down fascinating byways showing how the Sultan's cannon were cast, how children prayed for rain, how the people passed the nights of Ramadan and how important a social occasion for women were the weekly visits to the hammam, the public baths.
