provided the launching pad for my first field study of lesser mouse lemurs in Madagascar during which I gained my initial inklings of exudate feeding. It was also in Brunoy that I met up with Pierre Charles Dominique who introduced me to pioneering observations of exudate feeding he had made during his field study of five loriform species in Gabon. This opened my eyes to a key feeding adaptation that has now been reported for at least 69 primate species in 12 families (Smith 1971, Chap. 3). Almost 20% of extant primate species. So exudativory is now firmly established as a dietary category for primates alongside the long recognized classes of faunivory including insectivory, frugivory and folivory. Soon after I encountered Charles Dominique he published the first synthetic account of his Gabon field study in a French language journal (Charles Dominique 1971). *The Evolution of Human Behavior* (Warren G.
