Functional Morphology of the Forelimb of Tupaiids (Mammalia, Scandentia) and Its Phylogenetic Implications

ABSTRACT In this study, the forelimb of 12 species of tupailds was analyzed functionally and compared to that of other archontan mammals. Several differences that relate to differential substrate use were found in the forelimb morphology of tunatids. These differences included shape of the scapula, length and orientation of the coracoid process, size of the lesser tuberosity, shape of the capitulum, length of the elecranon process, and shape of the radial head and central fossa. The forelimb of the arboreal Ptilocercus lowii, the only ptilocercine, is better adapted for arboreal locomotion, while that of tupaiines is better adapted for terrestrial (or scansorial) locomotion. While the forelimb of the arboreal Ptilocercus appears to be habitually flexed and exhibits more mobility in its joints, a necessity for movement on uneven, discontinuous arboreal supports, all tupaiines are characterized by more extended forelimbs and less mobility in their joints. These restricted joints limit movements more to the parasagittal plane, which increases the efficiency of locomotion on a

more even and continuous surface like the ground. Even the most arboreal tupatines remain similar to their terrestrial relatives in their forelimb morphology, which probably reflects the terrestrial ancestry of Tupatinae (but not Tunaiidae). The forelimb of Urosale everetti is unique among tupatines in that it exhibits adaptations for scratch-digging. Several features of the tupaiid ferelimb reflect the arboreal ancestry of Tupaiidae and it is proposed that the ancestral tupaiid was arboreal like Philocercus. Also, compared to the ferelimb character states of tupatines, those of Prilocercus are more similar to those of other archontans and it is proposed that the attributes of the forelimb of Prifocerous are primitive for the Tupaiidae. The postcranial morphology of tree shrews (Scandentia, Tupaiidae) is relatively poorly known and has not been studied from a functional morphological perspective. However, the forelimb myology of tupaiids has been well described by Le Gros Clark (1924, 1926) and George (1973, 1977). Endo et al. (1999) recently studied the functional morphology of one tupaiid species, Dendrogale murina, and made several conclusions about its forelimb morphology and myology. However, there are several problems with this study (see below).

Stafford and Thorington (1998) studied the carpus of several mammals, including tupatids. Their study of carpal morphology went beyond an examination of carpal patterns, in that developmental data were incorporated into the analysis. Their work makes the wrist the one well-studied region of the tupaild forelimb, and I will be able to contribute little beyond their conclusions. However, I will note when I concur with their assessment and when I disagree with it.

In this analysis, both Ptilocercinae (Ptilocercus lowii) and Tupaiinae (Tupaia, Dendrogale, and Urogale; also Anathana, which could not be included in this analysis due to lack of specimens) were represented, and both arboreal (Ptilocercus and Tupaia minor) and terrestrial (particularly Urogale everetti and Tupaia tana) tupaiids were examined. It should be pointed out, however, that arboreal and terrestrial differences in the tupaiid postcranium are often split down the subfamilial line (Sargis, 2001a) because Ptilocercus, on the one hand, is arboreal (Lim, 1967, 1969; Muul and Lim, 1971; Gould, 1978), and most tupaiines, with the exception of T. minor (Lim, 1969; D'Souza, 1974) and possibly T. nicobarica
