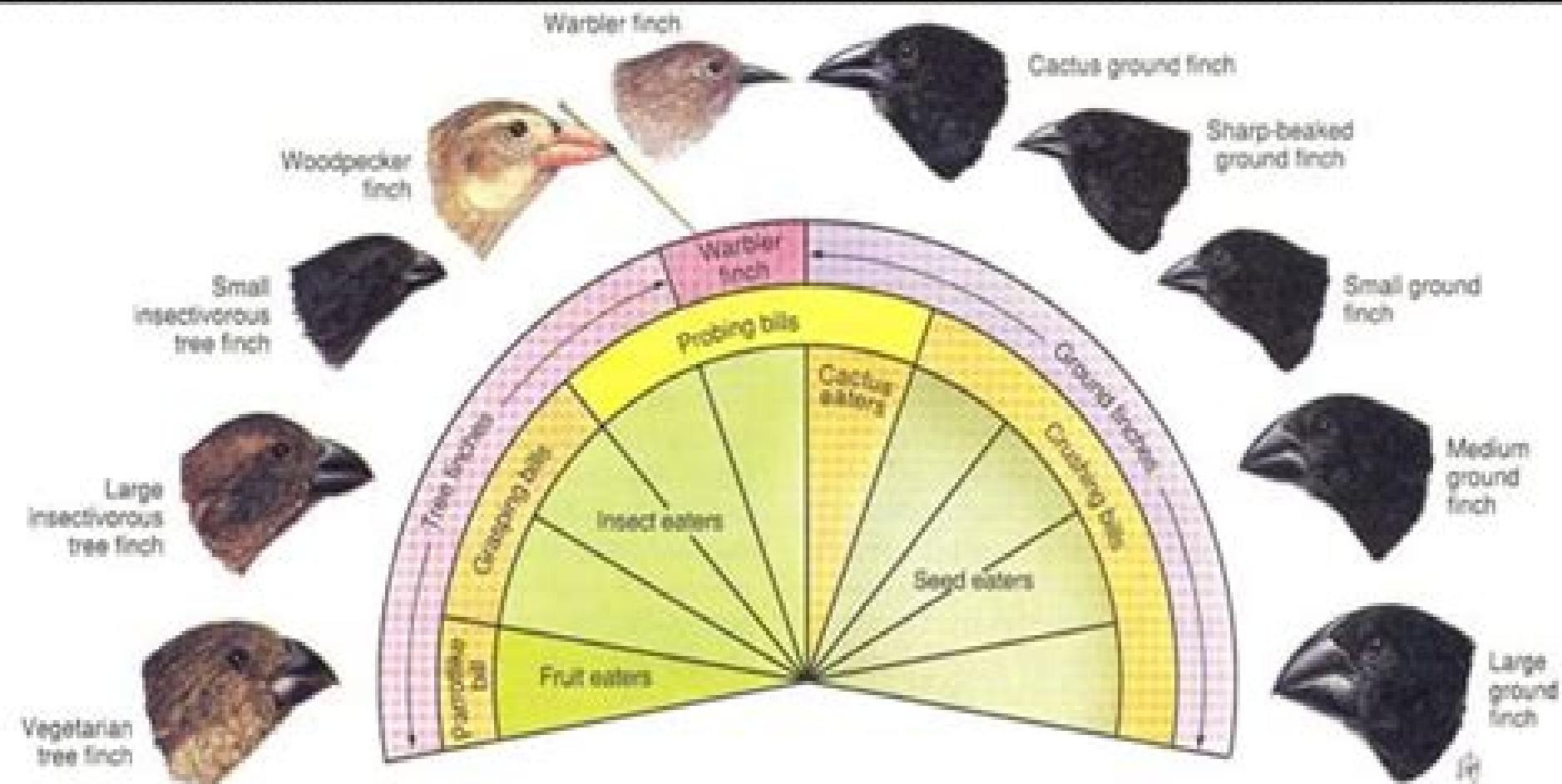

comprehensive understanding of the evolution of such volcanoes and to the eventual formulation of a unified model for ocean island evolution. Ocean islands are especially vulnerable to volcanic eruptions and other geological hazards on account of their typical small size, rough topography and isolation which make risk management and evacuation difficult. Volcanic eruptions in particular may have a significant impact on local populations, infrastructures, economy and even on the global climate. It is therefore fundamental to monitor these volcanoes with complementary geophysical, geodetic and geochemical techniques in order to forecast future eruptions and their impacts. However, the assessment of volcanic hazards on ocean islands is challenging due to the large variety of phenomena involved, e.g. lava flows, tephra fallout, pyroclastic density currents, lahars, gas emissions. Different approaches are used to assess volcanic hazards, either based on empirical methods or sophisticated numerical models focusing on a single phenomenon or the combination of different hazards.
