

Oueiroga, 2025-01-14 The tumour microenvironment TME is essential for cancer maintenance and is responsible for several antitumor characteristics such as immune system avoidance resistance to anticancer therapies invasion and metastasis The TME is composed of several components including fibroblasts extracellular matrix proteins pericytes and immune cells The immune cells including T lymphocytes are responsible for fighting cancer cells inducing cell death However cancer cells develop several mechanisms to avoid the immune system including mutations to change the antigens originally recognised by T cells Tumours that can avoid the immune system including the T cell antitumor response are known as nonimmunogenic tumours or cold tumours. The main characteristic of this tumour subtype is lack of response to immunotherapy drugs. In contrast immunogenic or hot tumours have an active T cell antitumor response and respond well to immunotherapy Therefore elucidating the TME characteristics is the first step for the application in clinical practice.
