municipality or the ideal speech community of cosmopolitanism but the ecological footprint Most governments around the world have signed up to sustainable development and they cannot afford to ignore ecological citizenship as a means of getting there Government policies usually revolve around financial sticks and carrots but these leave people uncommitted to the idea of sustainability and only to the rewards that are attached to it Dobson contrasts citizenship with fiscal incentives as a way of encouraging people to act more sustainably in the belief that the former is more compatible with the long term and deeper shifts of attitude and behaviour that sustainability requires Both citizenship and sustainability though are often viewed with suspicion in liberal societies because they refuse to accept the inviolability of individual preferences Dobson therefore offers an original account of the relationship between liberalism and sustainability arguing that the former's commitment to a plurality of conceptions of the good entails a commitment to so called strong forms of the latter How to make an ecological citizen Dobson examines the potential of formal high school citizenship education programmes through a case study of the recent implementation of the compulsory citizenship curriculum in the UK He concludes that the Department of Education and Skills has constructed a Trojan horse capable of kick starting ecological citizenship if teachers are willing and able to travel in it This book will be of interest to those working in the fields of environmental political theory citizenship globalisation cosmopolitanism liberalism and citizenship education
