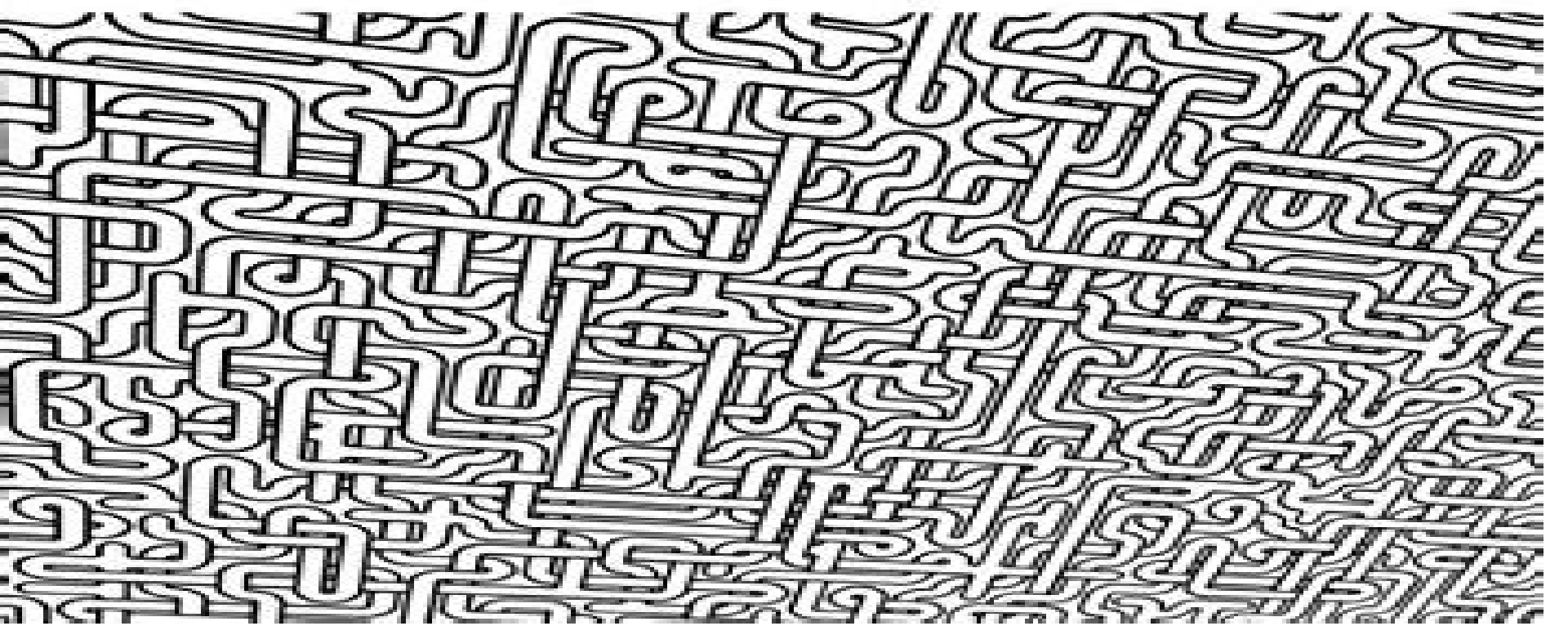

La investigación sociológica artesanal es laberíntica porque muchos caminos nos llevan a experimentar que escribir es una acción muy difícil. En cambio hay senderos que nos trasladan al aprendizaje de la escritura. El laberinto en la narrativa hispanoamericana contemporánea Ludmila Kapschutschenko, 1981 *La investigación biomédica y sus laberintos* Luis Carlos Silva Ayçaguer, 2008-12. Esta obra hace un pormenorizado recorrido por las variadas zonas de la realidad que circunda al investigador en el mundo sanitario. El autor penetra con agudeza y originalidad en las amenazas y oportunidades que ofrecen los diversos escenarios en que se desenvuelve la investigación biomédica contemporánea. La emergencia de Internet como poderoso instrumento de comunicación, el inquietante papel de la prensa y de las transnacionales del medicamento, los mitos numéricos y pseudocientíficos que amenazan a una genuina cultura científica de la sociedad, las pautas para el debate científico y el desmontaje de las ceremonias metodológicas más extendidas son algunos de los temas que se ofrecen al lector.
