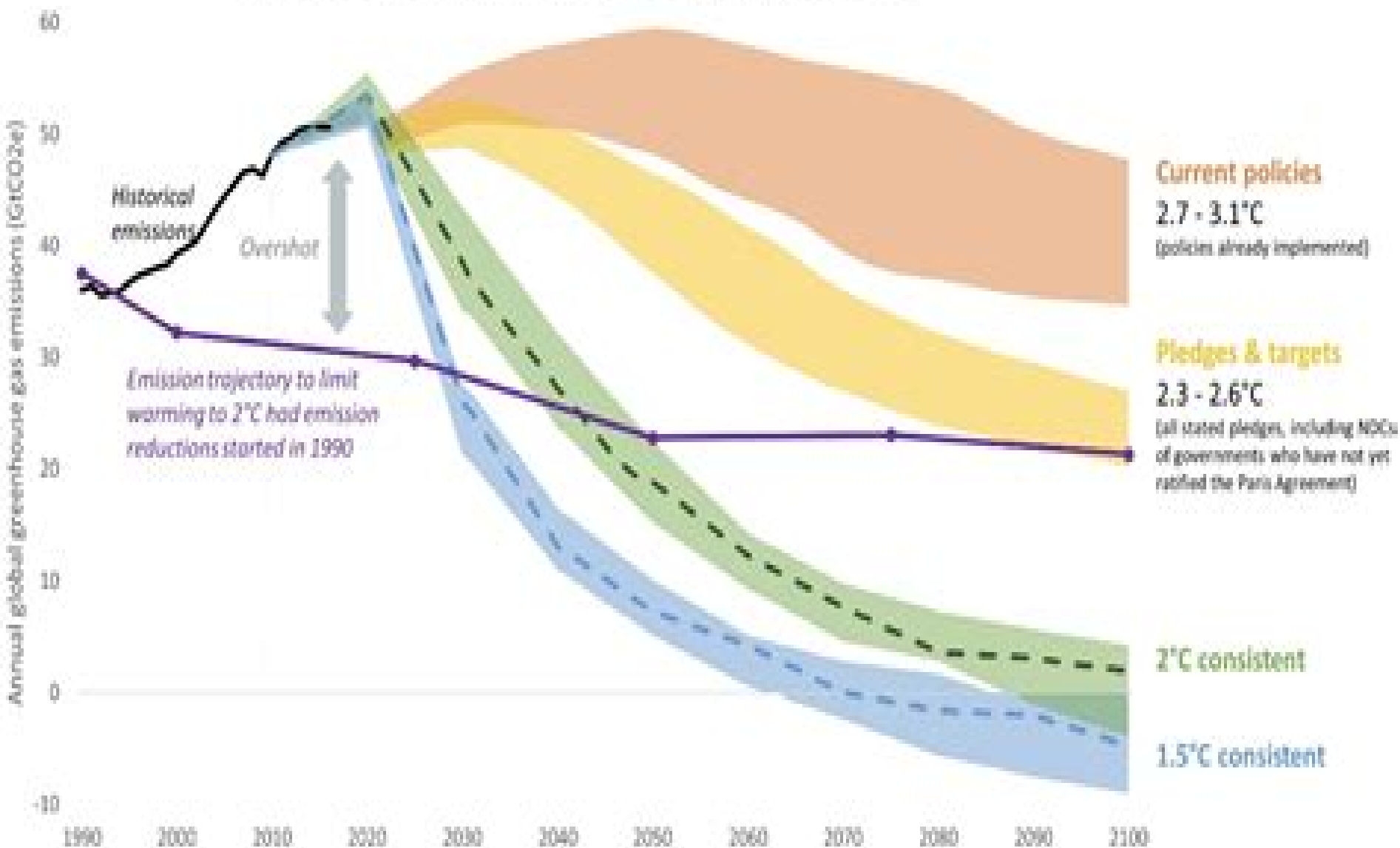


Global greenhouse gas emissions and warming scenarios
