solving core the procedural competence the other was the representation of the problem environment In the analogy the concepts knowledge and techniques of psychology constitute the core competence the health system in all its complexity is the problem environment A health psychologist is one whose basic competence in psychology is augmented by a working knowledge of some aspect of the health system Quite apparently there are functionally distinct aspects of health psychology to the degree that there are meaningful subdivisions in psychological competence and significantly different microenvironments within the health system I hesitate to refer to them as areas of specialization as the man who gave health psychology its formal definition Joseph Matarazzo has said that there are no specialties in psychology cited in the editors preface to this book
