unusual view of protectionism a labor business alliance and American exceptionalism offers striking parallels to today as the US struggles to define its international role and to determine the best blend of free trade protectionism and immigration William McKinley was the first US president to address globalization his legacy in protectionism and immigrant labor offer lessons for the current era He orchestrated an alliance between big business and the American worker that ushered in one of the greatest periods of growth ever known in the US economy Yet McKinley has been in the shadow of his successor Theodore Roosevelt for over a hundred years As Chairman of the Ways and Means Committee McKinley had forged a tariff bill in 1888 that united a nation that was still divided between North and South East and West His continued efforts to support free trade protected by managed markets in the tradition of Henry Clay and worker benefits like those provide by George Westinghouse led to a great economic compromise Further with revolutionary visionary rhetoric laden with America s economic manifest destiny he appealed to everyone from the steelworkers of Pittsburgh to the New York bankers He articulated a uniting philosophy Free trade in the United States is founded upon a community of equalities and reciprocities Free foreign trade admits the foreigner to equal privileges with our citizens It invites the product of foreign cheap labor to this market in competition with the domestic representing better paid labor albeit with tariffs to protect that domestic product McKinley s vision built the industrial base of the nation By the end of his presidency the American steel glass rubber oil machinery and electrical appliance industries dominated the world He was one of America s most popular presidents As his funeral train crossed the nation in 1901 factory workers and captains of industry alike stood along the rails to mourn him Never since has such a political alliance between labor and management been forged He was the last president to build a voting alliance between laborers immigrant workers and capitalists That alliance was marred by famous labor strikes and the building of great trusts yet he still managed to sweep the labor votes in the great industrial centers due to his belief in reciprocity and protectionism McKinley s role as a dinner pail Republican offers insights into how America can approach today s globalization with the best interests of the home team in mind

Parsons, 2025-11-11 Back in print for the first time in decades A classic in US labor history On May 1 1886 Albert and Lucy Parsons led upwards of 80 000 striking workers and their supporters through the streets of Chicago Across the country workers were advocating for the eight hour day On May 3 police killed two striking workers on the west side of Chicago In response a rally was called for May 4 1886 at Haymarket Square in Chicago There a bomb was thrown eventually killing seven policeman and wounding dozens of others Eight anarchists were accused four were hanged two had their sentences commuted one served six years and one died by suicide in his cell Accused and convicted of conspiracy the state of Illinois couldn't prove any of them threw the bomb so they instead tried to kill the anarchist movement This miscarriage of justice ignited labor movements across the United States and around the world Collected here are the voices of the accused from their sentencing in the fall of 1886 For decades after Albert was hanged Lucy Parsons carried on her husband's legacy through writing public speaking and publishing The Famous Speeches of the Eight Chicago Anarchists The chilling and defiant words of the accused six of whom were not even at Haymarket Square the night of the bombing are gripping still these many years later If you think that you can crush out these ideas that are gaining ground more and more every day if you think you can crush them out by sending us to the gallows if you would once more have people suffer the penalty of death because they have dared to tell the truth and I defy you to show us where we have told a lie I say if death is the penalty for proclaiming the truth then I will proudly and defiantly pay the costly price Call your hangman August Spies For such a government as this I can feel no respect and will combat them despite their power despite their police despite their spies I hate and combat not the individual capitalist but the system that gives him those privileges My greatest wish is that workingmen may recognize who are their friends and who are their enemies As to my conviction brought about as it was through capitalistic influence I have not one word to say George Engel I will ask you to hang me too for I think it is more honorable to die suddenly than to be killed by inches I have a family and children and if they know their father is dead they will bury him They can go to the grave and kneel down by the side of it but they can't go to the penitentiary and see their father who was convicted for a crime that he hasn't had anything to do with That is all I have got to say Your honor I am sorry I am not to be hung with the rest of the men Oscar Neebe Speeches from August Spies Michael Schwab Oscar Neebe

The violence of the press the bitter denunciation of the accused the attacks on all foreigners turned our sympathies to the Haymarket victims Emma Goldman Although it s no longer well known as a flashpoint few things were as controversial during the late 19th century as the Haymarket Affair Depending on one s perspective the riots and the violence that ensued were the result of anarchist terrorists attacking law enforcement authorities with a homemade bomb that was detonated during a large public event killing a police officer and wounding several more Others who were more sympathetic to the plight of the people protesting for better working conditions that night in Haymarket Square in Chicago on May 4 1886 portray it as a peaceful rally that was marred by a heavy handed response attempting to disperse the protesters What is clear is that the moments following the explosion were characterized by confusion and bedlam as some people ran away and others ran toward the site By the time the shooting was done nearly a dozen lay dead including a number of police officers and makeshift hospitals were soon overwhelmed Citizens in the area began to cry out for justice and police detectives poured through the city making arrests and questioning thousands As word spread about the attack cities around the country went on high alert concerned that they could be next It was soon determined that a traditionally anti American group was responsible for the attack and many threatened mob violence against anyone who looked like they might be involved with the group The press egged on those in the public with cries for revenge and justice Eventually the suspected perpetrators trial began a sensational event followed closely by many across the nation Tensions ran high as those involved were prosecuted and defended and when the jury convicted 8 anarchists of conspiracy and some of them were sentenced to death many rejoiced while others cried out that Lady Justice had miscarried the case Lost amidst the violence was the fact that the protests that culminated with the Haymarket Affair had come in response to previous labor strikes across the country and controversial police shootings of some workers on strike which took on a discriminatory undertone because many of the laborers were immigrants facing poor working conditions It was against this backdrop that political anarchists also got involved which muddled things and ultimately brought blowback against immigrant communities after the Haymarket Affair More importantly workers and those advocating on their behalf were galvanized by the events to push for what they considered much needed reforms many of which would come over the next few decades As professor William J Adelman put it No single event has influenced the history of labor in Illinois the United States and even the world more than the Chicago Haymarket Affair It began with a rally on May 4 1886 but the consequences are still being felt today Chicago has since commemorated both the workers and the police with various memorials and plaques [Chicago Haymarket Affair, The: A Guide to a Labor Rights Milestone](#) Joseph Anthony Rulli, 2016 On May 4 1886 a bomb exploded during a labor demonstration near Haymarket Square The ensuing gunfire and chaos brought a grisly end to what began as peaceful support for an eight hour workday and led to the trial and execution of rally organizers The incident also drew irrevocable attention to a conversation about workers rights and the role of law enforcement that continues today In this guide to the key moments and
