It is writing directed to new modes of creating as well as new modes of understanding.

When I want to read a book I write one. So wrote the 19th century politician and novelist Benjamin Disraeli. Washington Irving said something very similar and it's a maxim which I've adopted as my own. Almost all of the writing I've done over many years has been based on wanting to read a book on a particular subject, a book which research told me didn't currently seem to exist. Carrying the Torch like all my other books to date was born out of the desire to read a good book on an interesting subject, finding nothing available that quite matched up to my expectations. I decided to write it myself. I wanted a good general book about the phenomenon of unrequited love in the world's art, how important a theme it has been in novels, poems, music and film for so long, why artists keep coming back to it again and again, what it actually is, what it feels like and how it might be explained, and so forth. I like to think that that's the book I've written. All the world loves a lover and most people, whether they openly admit it or not, and that includes a great many men, love a good love story. As I make clear in the book, it doesn't seem to matter if the story has a tragic or at least unhappy ending; we don't enjoy it any less and may even enjoy it all the more as the popularity of weepies in book or film form attests.

Conversable Worlds Jon Mee, 2011-09-15

Conversable Worlds addresses the emergence of the idea of the conversation of culture. Around 1700 a new commercial society was emerging that thought of its values as the product of exchanges between citizens. Conversation became increasingly important as a model and as a practice for how

community could be created A welter of publications in periodical essays in novels and in poetry enjoined the virtues of conversation These publications were enthusiastically read and discussed in book clubs and literary societies that created their own conversable worlds From some perspectives the freedom of a distinctively English conversation allowed for the collision of ideas and sentiments For others like Joseph Addison and David Hume ease of flow was the key issue and politeness the means of establishing a *via media* For Addison and Hume the feminization of culture promised to make women the sovereigns of what Hume called the conversable world As the culture seemed to open up to a multitude of voices anxieties appeared as to how far things should be allowed to go The unruliness of the crowd threatened to disrupt the channels of communication There was a parallel fear that mere feminized chatter might replace learning This book examines the influence of these developments on the idea of literature from 1762 through to 1830 Part I examines the conversational paradigm established by figures like Addison and Hume and the proliferation of conversable worlds into gatherings like Johnson's Club and Montagu's Bluestocking assemblies Part II looks at the transition from the eighteenth century to Romantic ideas of literary culture the question of the withdrawal from mixed social space the drive to sublimate verbal exchange into forms that retained dialogue without contention in places like Coleridge's conversation poems and the continuing tensions between ideas of the republic of letters as a space of vigorous exchange as opposed to the organic unfolding of consciousness

had prophesied experiences drunkenness as the life long humiliation described in his poems and letters Keats's complex dionysianism runs through *Endymion* and the late odes setting him at odds with his temperate hero Milton Men in the Romantic age such as Sheridan Byron Moore and Clare celebrate rowdy friendship with tales and songs of drinking Romantic women novelists such as Smith Edgeworth and Wollstonecraft depict these men stumbling home to abuse their wives Although excessive drinking is real in the period observers and participants can still maintain ambivalence about its power to release or to debase the human being

The Death of the Actor Martin Buzacott, 2013-10-31 In *The Death of the Actor* Martin Buzacott launches an all out attack on contemporary theatrical practice and performance theory which identifies the actor rather than the director as the key creative force in the performance of Shakespeare Because actors are absent from the site of Shakespearean meaning he argues the illusion of their centrality is sustained only by a rhetoric of heroism violence and imperialism
