Kerry Katona is one of Britain's most talked about celebrities juggling motherhood and a front page lifestyle with a very turbulent personal life. Her early childhood saw Kerry witness depression, financial hardship and even a suicide bid by her mother before being brought up in children's homes and by foster families. Aged just eighteen, however, her fortunes changed and she shot to stardom as one of the founding members of pop group Atomic Kitten, securing a succession of hit singles, sell out tours and a fairytale wedding to Westlife's Brian McFadden. Crowned Queen of the Jungle on *I'm a Celebrity Get Me Out of Here* and *Celebrity Mum* of the Year in 2004, it looked as though Kerry had left heartache behind for good.
