Five Great Modern Irish Plays, 1907 Five great Irish plays, 1941 **Five Great Modern Irish Plays** George Jean Nathan, 1967 **Irish Drama and Theatre Since 1950** Patrick Lonergan, 2019-02-21 Drawing on major new archival discoveries and recent research Patrick Lonergan presents an innovative account of Irish drama and theatre spanning the past seventy years Rather than offering a linear narrative the volume traces key themes to illustrate the relationship between theatre and changes in society In considering internationalization the Troubles in Northern Ireland the Celtic Tiger period feminism and the changing status of the Catholic Church in Ireland Lonergan asserts the power of theatre to act as an agent of change and uncovers the contribution of individual artists plays and productions in challenging societal norms **Irish Drama and Theatre since 1950** provides a wide ranging account of major developments combined with case studies of the premiere or revival of major plays the establishment of new companies and the influence of international work and artists including Tennessee Williams Chekhov and Brecht While bringing to the fore some of the untold stories and overlooked playwrights following the declaration of the Irish Republic Lonergan weaves into his account the many Irish theatre makers who have achieved international prominence in the period Samuel Beckett Siobh n McKenna and Brendan Behan in the 1950s continuing with Brian Friel and Tom Murphy and concluding with the playwrights who emerged in the late 1990s including Martin McDonagh Enda Walsh Conor McPherson Marie Jones and Marina Carr The contribution of major Irish companies to world theatre is also examined including both the Abbey and Gate theatres as well as Druid Field Day and Charabanc Through its engaging analysis of seventy years of Irish theatre this volume charts the acts of gradual but revolutionary change that are the story of Irish theatre and drama and of its social and cultural contexts Nine Irish Plays for Voices Eamon Grennan, 2023-03-28 A vibrant collection of short plays bringing Irish history and culture alive through an extraordinary collage of documents songs poems and texts In *Nine Irish Plays for Voices* award winning poet Eamon Grennan delves deep into key Irish subjects big small literary historical political biographical and illuminates them for today s audiences and readers These short plays draw from original material centering on important moments in Irish history and the formation of the Irish Republic such as the Great Famine and the Easter Rising the lives of Irish literary figures like Yeats Joyce and Lady Gregory and the crucial and life changing condition of emigration The rhythmic musical and vivid language of Grennan s plays incorporates traditional song lyrics lines of Irish poetry and letters and speeches of the time The result is a dramatic collage that tells a story through the voices of characters contemporary to the period of the play s subject By presenting subjects through the dramatic rendering of the human voice the plays facilitate a close intimate relationship between players and the audience creating an incredibly powerful connection to the past Historical moments and literary figures that might seem remote to the present day reader or audience become immediate and emotionally compelling One of the plays *Ferry* is drawn entirely from the author s imagination It puts unnamed characters who come from the world of

twentieth century Ireland on a boat to the underworld with the philosopher Ludwig Wittgenstein On their journey the five strangers played by two voices tell stories about their lives raising the question of how language both captures and transforms lived experience Addressing the Great Famine Hunger uses documentary evidence to give audiences a dramatic feel for what has been a silent and traumatic element in Irish history Noramollyannalivialucia The Muse and Mr Joyce is a one woman piece that depicts James Joyce s wife as an older woman sharing her memories and snippets from the works of her husband Also included in this rich volume is the author s adaptation of Synge s Aran Islands as well as Emigration Road History Reading the Easter Rising The Muse and Mr Yeats The Loves of Lady Gregory and Peig An Ordinary Life

Lonergan Contemporary Irish Plays is a timely reminder of the long held tradition and strength of Irish theatre which blossoms even in its new found circumstances

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The Irish Drama of Europe from Yeats to Beckett Katharine Worth,2014-01-13 This study provides a European perspective on the drama of Yeats and of the Irish playwrights Wilde and Synge O Casey and Beckett who share in the achievement of creating a modern drama of the interior Professor Worth traces in particular the influence of Maeterlinck examining his static drama in some detail A dominant theme is the importance of total theatre techniques to the playwrights of the interior from Wilde in *Salome* to O Casey in plays like *Cock a Doodle Dandy* Yeats is seen as the great pioneer assimilating inspiration from the French with Arthur Symonds as guide from Synge from Gordon Craig and from the *No drama* and evolving a modern technique for a drama of complex self consciousness

Buffoonery in Irish Drama Kathleen Heininge,2009 Generations of Irish playwrights have tried to assert the reputation of the stage Irish figure as other than comic but each effort was in its turn assailed as buffoonery Using post colonial and performative theory Buffoonery in Irish Drama demonstrates the ways the Irish struggled

Miller,2007-10-25 In this survey of eighteenth and nineteenth century American drama Tice L Miller examines American plays written before a canon was established in American dramatic literature and provides analyses central to the culture that produced them *Entertaining the Nation* American Drama in the Eighteenth and Nineteenth Centuries evaluates plays in the early years of the republic reveals shifts in taste from the classical to the contemporary in the 1840s and 1850s and considers the increasing influence of realism at the end of the nineteenth century Miller explores the relationship between American drama and societal issues during this period While never completely shedding its English roots says Miller the American drama addressed issues important on this side of the Atlantic such as egalitarianism republicanism immigration slavery the West Wall Street and the Civil War In considering the theme of egalitarianism the volume notes Alexis de Tocqueville s observation in 1831 that equality was more important to Americans than liberty Also addressed is the Yankee character which became a staple in American comedy for much of the nineteenth century Miller analyzes several English plays and notes how David Garrick s reforms in London were carried over to the colonies Garrick faced an increasingly middle class public offers Miller and had to make adjustments to plays and to his repertory to draw an audience The volume also looks at the shift in drama that paralleled the one in political power from the aristocrats who founded the nation to Jacksonian democrats Miller traces how the proliferation of newspapers developed a demand for plays that reflected contemporary society and details how playwrights scrambled to put those symbols of the outside world on stage to appeal to the public Steamships and trains slavery and adaptations of Uncle Tom s Cabin and French influences are presented as popular subjects during that time *Entertaining the Nation* effectively outlines the civilizing force of drama in the establishment and development of the nation ameliorating differences among the various theatergoing classes and provides a microcosm of the changes on and off the stage in America during these two centuries
