Eichmann Interrogated Adolf Eichmann, 1999-05-06 As head of the Gestapo's Jewish Evacuation Department Lieutenant Colonel Adolf Eichmann 1906-1962 was the driving force in the impoverishment, deportation and extermination of millions of Jews.
