The second is ecology, particularly the structure and dynamics of populations. The third is conservation. I first published a few ideas about the significance of invasions in 1943 in a war-time review called *Polish Science and Learning* under the title of *The Changing Realms of Animal Life*. Since then, I have had the opportunity to think pretty hard about conservation while taking part in the planning and development of the Nature Conservancy. In March 1957, I gave three broadcasts in the BBC's Third Programme under the title of *Balance and Barrier*.
