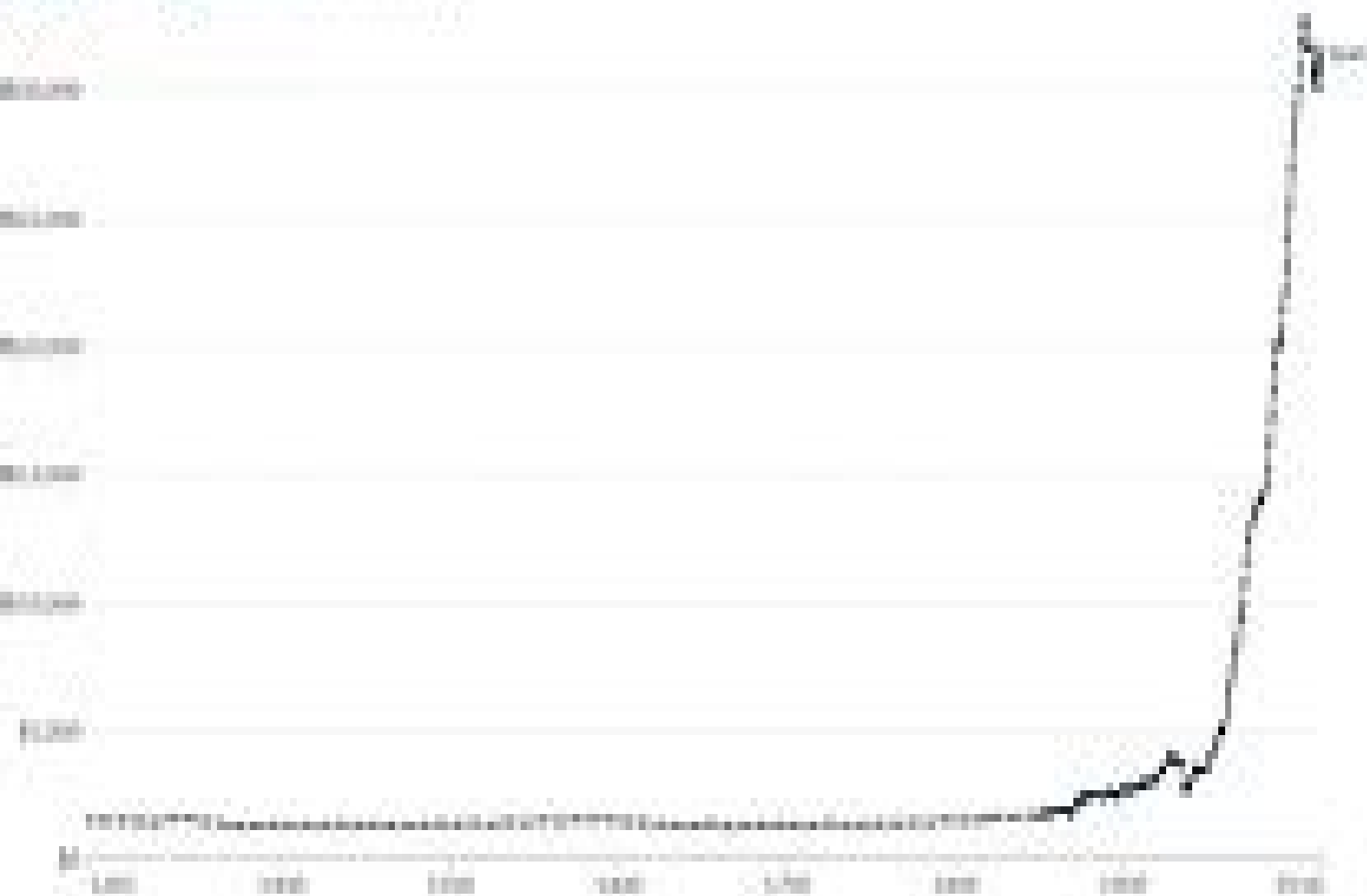


U.S. GDP per capita, 1200 to 2000
