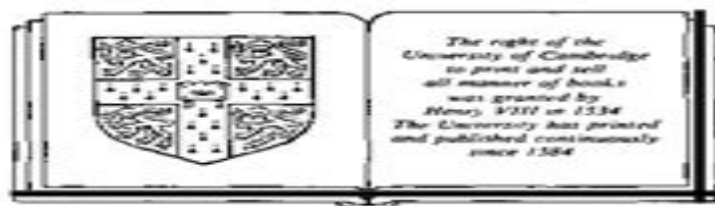

Rush argues that this is primarily a social ontological term and not as is often supposed a metaphysical concept. Kierkegaard although critical of the romantic conception deploys his own adaptation of it in his criticism of Hegel, continuing and in a way completing the arc of irony through nineteenth century philosophy. The book concludes by offering suggestions meant to guide contemporary reconsideration of Schlegel's and Kierkegaard's views on the philosophical significance of irony.
