In the twelfth century an Italian monk named Joachim caught the attention of the Christian West by announcing the Three Ages of the World. Gilk goes on to assert that the radical servanthood and radical stewardship contained within Jesus' kingdom of God proclamation is at least in part an attempt to spiritually reconnect with the agrarian village culture of the Mother's Age, but it's also a lifting of that Age to a finer spirituality and toward an ethically Green political order. The kingdom of God is Green, Gilk says, and its overarching divinity is the Daughter. The Age of the Daughter is Green and is struggling to be born.
