- Catch up with evolving realities and enable desired development to occur;
- Consequence of governmental bargaining (some governments inevitable disappointed with the outcome of the treaties and start pressing for another round even during ratification);
- The last three treaties Maastricht Amsterdam – Nice – have especially provided for further rounds reform.
