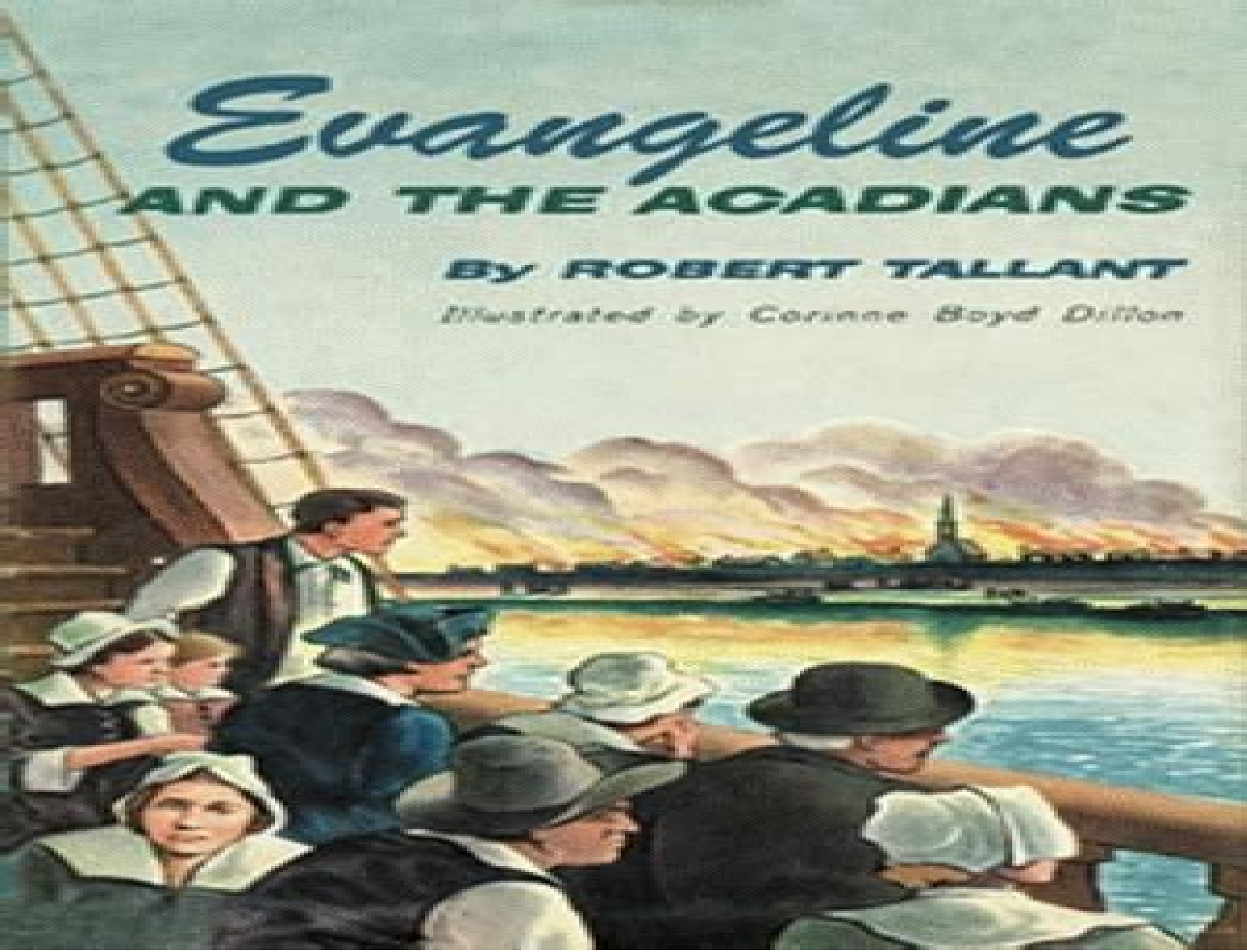

how history can be gleaned from resources such as scrapbooks newspapers correspondence and diaries Although the diary and annotations are in English half of the 46 newspaper articles and other items in the scrapbook materials are in French
