After looking at economic problems and human values and the way in which they are made, Professor Wogaman asks whether there is a theological basis for social priorities. He then considers contemporary economic realities in general before focussing on more specific issues like equity and security, employment and education, opportunity, conservation and the need for a new world order before inexorably forcing home his final conclusions.
