

**An Ecumenical Statement
on the Meaning of Ordination:
Based on the Study, *Rituals of Ordination
and Commitment in Churches in the Nordic Countries.*
*Theology and Terminology***

Introduction

In 1997 the Nordic Ecumenical Council decided to initiate a study process on *Theology and Terminology of Rituals for Ordination in the Churches in the Nordic Countries*.¹ From 1998–2003 ecumenical study groups on ordination in the Nordic Churches took place. In addition to these, a research project, funded by NOS-H, was carried out under the joint leadership of the signers of this report.² This group was convened and coordinated by Hans Raun Iversen, Faculty of Theology, University of Copenhagen. The general results of the research project appear in our book, *Rituals of Ordination and Commitment in Churches in the Nordic Countries. Theology and Terminology*.³

Before our members depart and return to their respective homes, and having studied ordination rituals together and listened to representatives from the Nordic Churches, we desire to share with the churches some insights and learnings that include:

- 1) Some theological remarks on the findings in our study and
- 2) Some observations for the churches to consider whenever they work with their ordination rituals or have the opportunity to start a study process on the theology of ordained ministry.
