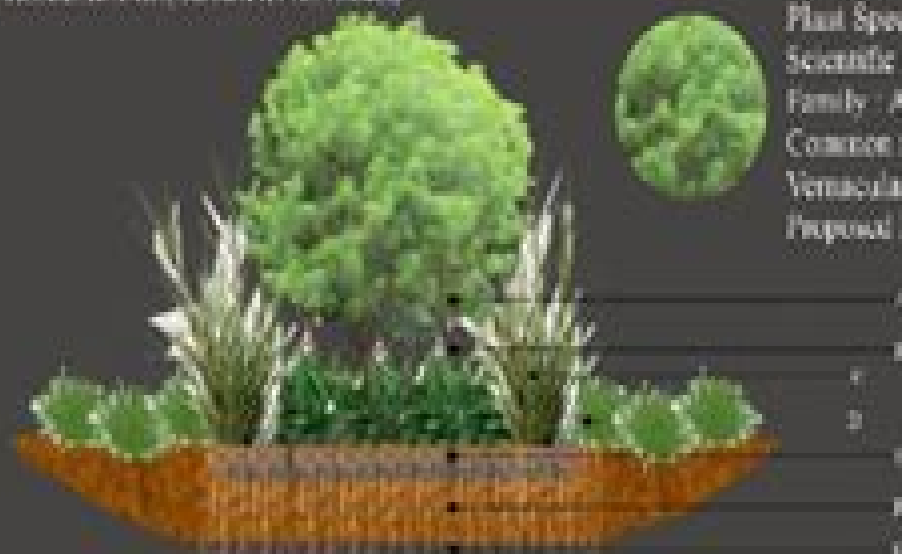

1. Plants selected are native/naturalized species of India/ Karnataka and have deep, taproot systems capable of sustaining in hot and dry conditions. Their long roots hold the water during drought conditions and aid in filtering pollutants from the road.
2. Selected tall plant species will eventually serve as a visual barrier to protect drivers from getting distracted by the headlights of the vehicles in the opposite lanes.
