

institutions Greenberg shows that members of all socioeconomic classes understood the triad of girls education modernity and the nationalist struggle as educated girls would become the mothers of tomorrow who would raise nationalist and modern children While this was the aim of the various schools in Palestine not all educated Muslim girls followed this path as some used their education even if it was elementary at best to become teachers nurses and activists in women s organizations
