Ways forward in higher education

Adjust financing schemes for the poor to benefit. Examine and tackle social determinants, such as income, that limit households to low-cost and low-quality higher education. Free tuition may help, but educational grants beyond tuition should also be prioritized to motivate the poorest household members to pursue higher education.

Promote the complementary relationship between private and public school education. Private and public schools both have something to offer. Harness their strengths to diversify options for pursuing education.

Improve education inputs. Promote voluntary accreditation. Encourage more HEIs to become recognized centers for excellence. Address low teacher qualifications.

Develop a research culture and build a functional innovation system. There must be enabling policies that encourage technological developments and network-building among HEIs. This system should also actively link students to the scientific community and market innovations.

Learn from the pandemic. Leverage technology to support learning. This includes ensuring availability, affordability, and meaningful access. Regularly produce and study granular data to uncover barriers to pursuing and implementing quality higher education.
