The 'Small Landscape' Prints in Early Modern Netherlands Alexandra Onuf,2017-01-02 In 1559 and 1561 the Antwerp print publisher Hieronymus Cock issued an unprecedented series of landscape prints known today simply as the Small Landscapes. The forty four prints included in the series offer views of the local countryside surrounding Antwerp in simple unembellished compositions.
