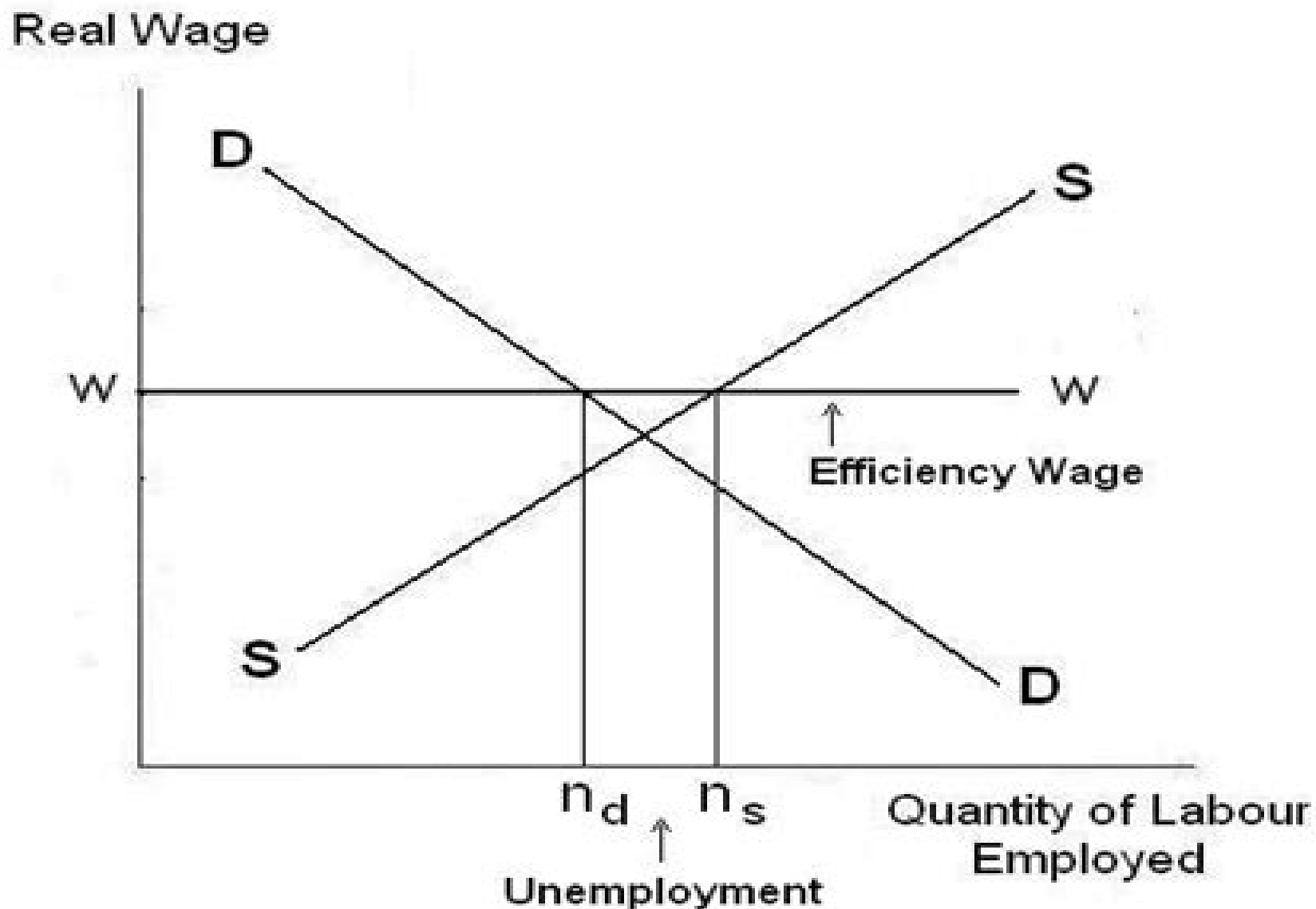


Figure 1. Efficiency Wage
