Egypt Under Mubarak:

Egypt Under Mubarak Roger Owen, Charles Tripp, 2013-04-15 Egypt is one of the major powers in the Middle East. The vigour of its cultural life and the extent of its influence make it a force which cannot be ignored in the Arab world. Yet despite the comparative confidence with which its rulers handle power, the country has a politically contradictory past with which to come to terms as well as its role in a region of shifting political identity and allegiance. This book examines the causes and consequences of the many crises within the Egyptian political, sociological, economic and moral legacy and the strategies which Mubarak's government has devised to cope with that legacy. The book's concern is for the capacity of the present administration to avoid expediency and the generation of further crisis and rather to employ Egypt's considerable resources in the shaping of a distinct and effective role for the country.

The Autumn of Dictatorship Samer Soliman, 2011-04-01 The Egyptian protests in early 2011 took many by surprise. In the days immediately following, commentators wondered openly over the changing situation across the Middle East. But protest is nothing new to Egypt and labor activism and political activism, most notably the Kifaya Enough movement, have increased dramatically over recent years. In hindsight, it is the durability of the Mubarak regime, not its sudden loss of legitimacy, that should be more surprising. Though many have turned to social media for explanation of the events in this book, Samer Soliman follows the age-old adage: follow the money. Over the last thirty years, the Egyptian state has increasingly given its citizens less money and fewer social benefits while simultaneously demanding more taxes and resources. This has led to a weakened state, deteriorating public services, low levels of law enforcement, poor opportunities for employment and economic development while simultaneously inflating the security machine that sustains the authoritarian regime. Studying the regime from the point of view of its deeds rather than its discourse, this book tackles the relationship between fiscal crisis and political change in Egypt. Ultimately, the Egyptian case is not one of the success of a regime but the failure of a state. The regime lasted for 30 years because it was able to sustain and reproduce itself but left an increasingly weakened state unable to facilitate capitalist development in the country. The resulting financial crisis profoundly changed the socio-economic landscape of the country and now is paving the way for political change and the emergence of new social forces.

The Egyptian Revolution Mohamed El-Bendary, 2013 **Egypt Under the Khedives, 1805-1879** F. Robert Hunter, 1999 Robert Hunter's *Egypt Under the Khedives* brought back into print in this paperback edition was a pioneering work when first published in the 1980s as Western scholars began to comb Egypt's national archives for an understanding of the social and economic history of the country.
