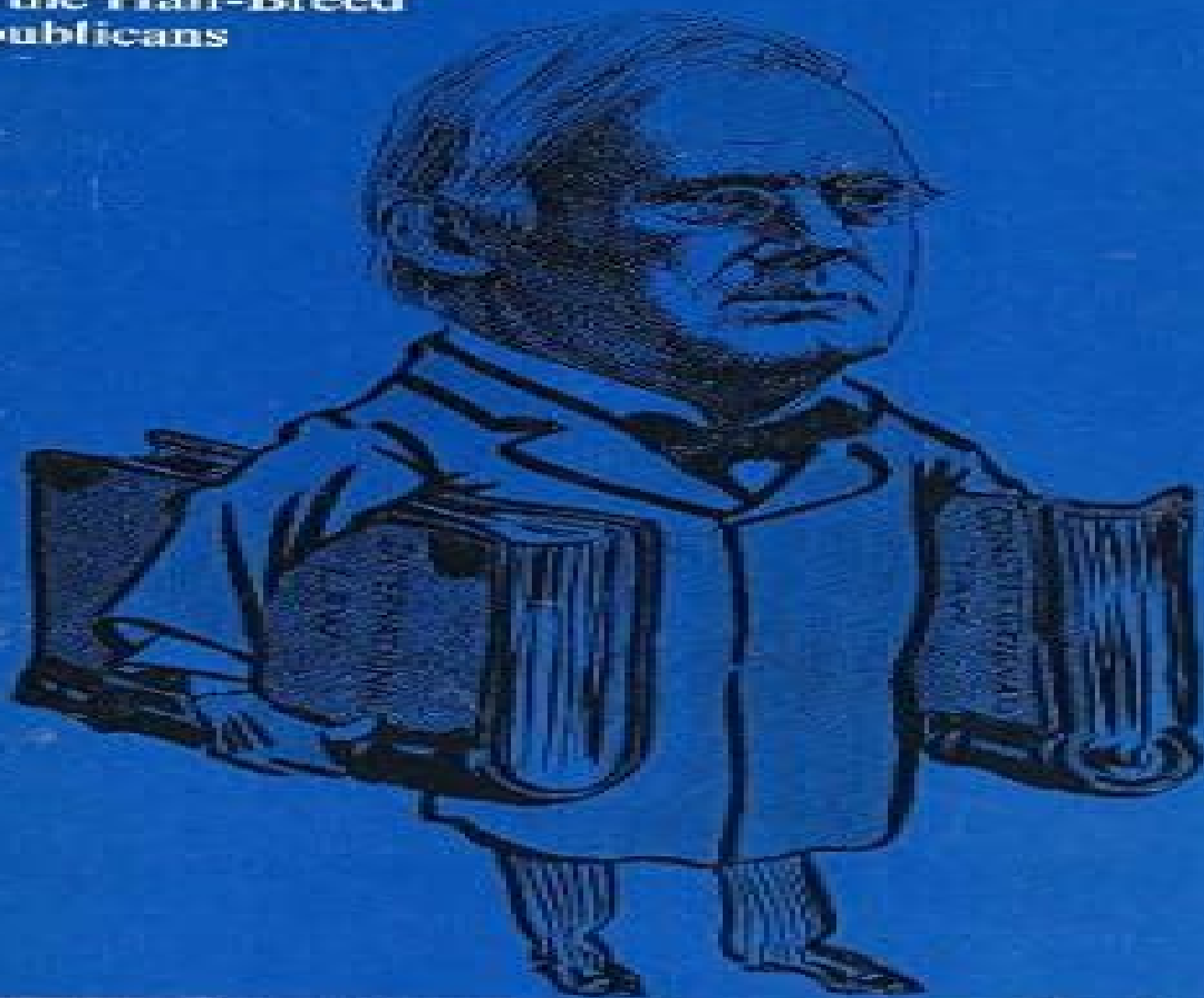

Welch,1971 **George Frisbie Hoar and the Half-breed Republicans** ,1971 *Henry Watterson and the New South* Daniel Margolies,2006-11-24 Henry Watterson editor of the Louisville Courier Journal during the tumultuous decades between the Civil War and World War I was one of the most influential and widely read journalists in American history At the height of his fame in the early twentieth century Watterson was so well known that his name and image were used to sell cigars and whiskey A major player in American politics for more than fifty years Watterson personally knew nearly every president from Andrew Jackson to Woodrow Wilson Though he always refused to run the renowned editor was frequently touted as a candidate for the U S Senate the Kentucky governor s office and even the White House Shortly after his arrival in Louisville in 1868 Watterson merged competing interests and formed the Courier Journal quickly establishing it as the paper of record in Kentucky a central promoter of economic development in the New South and a prominent voice on the national political stage An avowed Democrat in an era when newspapers were openly aligned with political parties Watterson adopted a defiant independence within the Democratic Party and challenged the Democrats consensus opinions as much as he reinforced them In the first new study of Watterson s historical significance in more than fifty years Daniel S Margolies traces the development of Watterson s political and economic positions and his transformation from a strident Confederate newspaper editor into an admirer of Lincoln a powerful voice of sectional reconciliation and the nation s premier advocate of free trade *Henry Watterson and the New South* provides the first study of Watterson s unique attempt to guide regional and national discussions of foreign affairs Margolies details Watterson s quest to solve the sovereignty problems of the 1870s and to quell the economic and social upheavals of the 1890s through an expansive empire of free trade Watterson s political and editorial contemporaries variously advocated free silverism protectionism and isolationism but he rejected their narrow focus and maintained that the best way to improve the South s fortunes was to expand its economic activities to a truly global scale Watterson s *New Departure* in foreign affairs was an often contradictory program of decentralized home rule and overseas imperialism but he remained steadfast in his vision of a prosperous and independent South within an American economic empire of unfettered free trade Watterson thus helped to bring about the eventual bipartisan embrace of globalization that came to define America s relationship with the rest of the world in the twentieth century Margolies groundbreaking analysis shows how Watterson s authoritative command of the nation s most divisive issues his rhetorical zeal and his willingness to stand against the tide of conventional wisdom made him a national icon *The Political Education of Henry Adams* Brooks D. characterized them as strangers in the land Only in 1965 did America's gates swing open to people like Luo's parents immigrants from Taiwan Today there are more than twenty two million people of Asian descent in the United States and yet the stranger label Luo writes remains Drawing on archives from across the country and written with a New Yorker writer's style and sweep *Strangers in the Land* is revelatory and unforgettable an essential American story The Papers of Jefferson Davis Jefferson Davis, 2012-03-12 Volume 13 of *The Papers of Jefferson Davis* follows the former president of the Confederacy as he becomes head of the Carolina Life Insurance Company of Memphis and attempts to gain a financial foothold for his newly reunited family Having lost everything in the Civil War and spent two years immediately afterwards in federal prison Davis faced a mounting array of financial woes health problems and family illnesses and tragedies in the 1870s Despite setbacks during this decade Davis also began a quest to rehabilitate his image and protect his historical legacy Although his position with the insurance company provided temporary financial stability Davis resigned after the Panic of 1873 forced the sale of the company and its new owners canceled payments to Carolina policyholders He left for England the following year in search of employment and to recuperate from ongoing illnesses In 1876 Davis became president of the London based Mississippi Valley Society and relocated to New Orleans to run the company Throughout the 1870s Davis waged an expensive and seemingly endless legal battle to regain his prewar Mississippi plantation Brierfield He also began working on his memoirs at Beauvoir the Gulf Coast estate of a family friend Though disfranchised Davis addressed the subject of politics with more frequency during this decade criticizing the Reconstruction policies of the federal government while defending the South and the former Confederacy The volume ends with Davis's inheritance of Beauvoir which was his last home The editors have drawn from over one hundred manuscript repositories and private collections in addition to numerous published sources in compiling Volume 13

The Presidency of William McKinley Lewis L. Gould, 1980 In this interpretation of the McKinley presidency Lewis L. Gould contends that William McKinley was the first modern president Making use of extensive original research in manuscript collections in the United States Great Britain and France Gould argues that during McKinley's four and a half years in the White House the executive office began to resemble the institution as the twentieth century would know it He rejects the erroneous stereotypes that have long obscured McKinley's historical significance McKinley as the compliant agent of Mark Hanna or as an irresolute executive in the Cuban crisis that led to war with Spain He contends that McKinley is an important figure in the history of the United States because of the large contributions he made to the strengthening and broadening of the power of the chief executive While this volume touches on many aspects of McKinley's leadership the core of it relates to the coming of the Spanish American War the president's conduct of the war itself and the emergence of an American empire from 1898 to 1900 According to Gould the Spanish American War was not the result presidential weakness or of cowardice before public hysteria McKinley sought to persuade Spain to relinquish Cuba peacefully turning to war only when it became apparent that Madrid would never acquiesce During

the war McKinley effectively directed the American military effort and the diplomacy that brought territorial acquisitions and peace The process of making peace with Spain involving as it did American annexation of the Philippines and of securing the ratification of the resulting treaty in the Senate underscored McKinley s expansive view of presidential power He functioned as chief diplomat from the sending of senators on the peace commission to the personal supervision of the terms of the negotiation At home he made tours of the West and South in 1898 to lead popular opinion to his position as no president had done before him For the Senate he evidenced a readiness to dispense patronage woo votes with personal persuasion and marshal the resources of the political system behind his treaty Later episodes in McKinley s administration support Gould s thesis In administering Puerto Rico and Cuba and in suppressing an insurrection in the Philippines McKinley relied further on the war power and continued to shape affairs from the White House He sent troops to china during the Boxer Rebellion in 1900 without congressional authorization governed the new possessions through presidential commissions and allowed Capitol Hill only a subsidiary role in the process By 1901 the nation had an empire and a president whose manner and bearing anticipated the imperial executives of six decades later Gould does not argue that McKinley was a great president He maintains instead that what McKinley contributed to the office the examples he offered and the precedents he set make him an important figure in the emergence of the modern presidency in this century Closing the Gate Andrew
