world was an inspiration to lifelong friend Thomas Jefferson who asked him in 1784 to lead a cross country expedition to the Pacific and back Clark turned Jefferson down Two decades later his youngest brother William would become the Clark celebrated as a member of the Corps of Discovery By the beginning of the nineteenth century though George Rogers Clark may not have been fit to command any expedition After the revolution he raged against the government and pledged fealty to other nations leading to his arrest under the Sedition Act The inner demons that fueled Clark s anger also drove him to excessive drinking He died at the age of sixty five bitter crippled and alcoholic He was Nester shows a self destructive hero a volatile multidimensional man whose glorying in war ultimately engaged him in conflicts far removed from the battlefield and against himself
