and everything in between Inevitably the chronology is quite long as it has a long period to cover and the introduction provides the necessary overview The Historical Dictionary of Early British Theatre concludes with a pretty massive bibliography That will be of use to particularly assiduous researchers but this book itself is a good place to start any research since it covers periods that are far less well known and documented and ordinary theatre goers will also find useful information
