Kosicki, 2021-12-10 This book focuses on the political exile of Catholic Christian Democrats during the global twentieth century from the end of the First World War to the end of the Cold War Transcending the common national approach the present volume puts transnational perspectives at center stage and in doing so aspires to be a genuinely global and longitudinal study Political Exile in the Global Twentieth Century includes chapters on continental European exile in the United Kingdom and North America through 1945 on Spanish exile following the Civil War 1936 39

The first eight focus on the British and Irish context, including studies of Jürgen Kuczynski and his family, Martin Miller, Lilly Kann, Hermann Sinsheimer, Albin Stuebs, Ludwig Hopf and Paul Bondy, as well as contributions on the Association of Jewish Refugees and the exile experience as reflected in Klaus Mann's *Der Vulkan*. Christoph Laucht offers the first investigation into the roles played by two German-born émigré atomic scientists, Klaus Fuchs and Rudolf Peierls, in the development of British nuclear culture, especially the practice of nuclear science and the political implications of the atomic scientists' work from the start of the Second World War until 1959.

**Translingual Identities** Tamar Steinitz, 2013. Explores the psychology of literary translingualism in the works of two authors, finding it expressed as loss and fragmentation in one case and as opportunity and mediation in the other. The works of translingual writers, those who write in a language other than their native tongue, present a rich field for study, but literary translingualism remains underresearched and

undertheorized In this work Tamar Steinitz explores the psychological effects of translingualism in the works of two authors the German Stefan Heym 1913 2001 and the Austrian Jakob Lind 1927 2007 Both were forced into exile by the rise of Nazism both chose English as a language of artistic expression Steinitz argues that translingualism which ruptures the perceived link between language and world as the writer chooses between systems of representation leads to a psychic split that can be expressed in the writer's work as a schizophrenic existence or as a productive doubling of perspective Movement between languages can thus reflect both the freedom associated with geographical mobility and the emotional price it entails Reading Lind's and Heym's works within their postwar context Steinitz proposes these authors as representative models respectively of translingualism as loss and fragmentation and translingualism as opportunity and mediation Tamar Steinitz teaches English literature at Queen Mary and Goldsmiths colleges University of London She has also worked as a literary translator

*Everyday Life as Alternative Space in Exile Writing* Andrea Hammel, 2008 This book is the first comparative study of the novels written by five German speaking women Anna Gmeyner Selma Kahn Hilde Spiel Martina Wied and Hermynia Zur Mühlen who had to flee National Socialist Central Europe Gmeyner Spiel Wied and Zur Mühlen found refuge in Britain and thus added together with male colleagues such as Stefan Zweig and Robert Neumann an important but rarely investigated new dimension to the British literary landscape The aim of this study is to reassess the women refugee writers narrative strategies and integrate their work within feminist literary studies The author investigates the five writers narrativisation of everyday life used to subvert the dominant discourse and their portrayal of the intersection between class racial and gender oppression She also shows their innovative ways of picturing the gendered tension between the experiences of exile and exile as a modernist metaphor as well as their search for ways to refute the Nationalist Socialist rewriting of history The book situates the novels within the theoretical discussions surrounding exile studies social history and women's writing

scenery historical grandeur and musical refinement The reality of the country they had left and the one to which some of them returned was very different This volume contains various studies of the representations of their homeland in the cultural production of Austrian exiles including those projected by migrants working in the British film industry those portrayed in the historical novel and in the literary works of such notable authors as Stefan Zweig Elias Canetti and Robert Neumann It opens with a survey of the make up of the Austrian exile community and concludes with a study of attitudes to returning exiles as reflected in the post war literary journals The volume thus offers students and teachers a vital cultural link between the pre 1934 Austria of the First Republic and the post 1945 Austria of the Second
