

So during late 1939 the armoured cruiser Deutschland and later the battlecruisers Scharnhorst and Gneisenau were used as commerce raiders to strike at Allied convoys in the North Atlantic These sorties met with mixed results but for Germany's naval high command they showed that this kind of operation had potential Then the fall of France Denmark and Norway in early 1940 dramatically altered the strategic situation The Atlantic was now far easier to reach and to escape from During 1940 further moderately successful sorties were made by the cruisers Admiral Scheer and Admiral Hipper By the end of the year with British mercantile losses mounting to surface raiders and U Boats plans were developed for a much larger raid first using both cruisers and then the two battlecruisers The climax of this was Operation Berlin the Kriegsmarine's largest and most wide ranging North Atlantic sortie so far Scharnhorst and Gneisenau remained at sea for two months destroying 22 Allied
