his skills as an orchestrator he pushed boundaries again in 1935 with the groundbreaking folk opera Porgy and Bess his magnum opus Gershwin s talent and warmth made him a presence in New York s musical and social circles and linked him romantically with pianist composer Kay Swift In 1936 he and Ira moved west to write songs for Hollywood Their work was cut short however when George developed a brain tumor and died at thirty eight a beloved American artist Drawing extensively from letters and contemporaneous accounts acclaimed music historian Richard Crawford traces the arc of Gershwin s remarkable life seamlessly blending colorful anecdotes with a discussion of Gershwin s unforgettable oeuvre His days on earth were limited to the summertime of life But the spirit and inventive vitality of the music he left behind lives on
