...where democratic principles provide for the common good, and promote the general welfare, and establish the justice and equality of the laws of the land.

Article I

Section 1. All legislative Powers herein granted shall be vested in a Congress of the United States, which shall consist of a Senate and House of Representatives.

Section 2. The House of Representatives shall be composed of Members chosen every second Year by the People of the several States, and the Electors in each State shall have the Qualifications requisite for Electors of the most numerous Branch of the State Legislature.

No Person shall be a Representative who shall not have attained to the Age of twenty five Years, seven Years, and a Day, who shall not, when elected, be seven Years a Citizen of the United States, and who shall not, when elected, be an Inhabitant of that State in which he shall be chosen.

Representatives and electors shall be apportioned among the several States which may be admitted to or accepted of by the United States according to their respective Numbers, which shall be determined by adding to the whole Number of free Persons, including those bound by Contract to serve for a Term of Years, and excluding Indians not taxed, three fifths of all other Persons.

The actual Enumeration shall be made within three Years after the first Meeting of the House of Representatives, and in every subsequent Year of Census.
