The Fleet Air Arm and the War in Europe, 1939-1945 David Hobbs, 2022-03-30 A comprehensive history of the Royal Navy's naval aviation component's campaigns during World War II. For the first time this book tells the story of how naval air operations evolved into a vital element of the Royal Navy's ability to fight a three-dimensional war against both the Kriegsmarine and Luftwaffe. An integral part of RN the Fleet Air Arm was not a large organization with only 406 pilots and 232 front-line aircraft available for operations in September 1939. Nevertheless its impact far outweighed its numbers; it was an RN fighter that shot down the first enemy aircraft of the war and an RN pilot was the first British fighter ace with 5 or more kills. The Fleet Air Arm's roll-call of achievements in northern waters went on to include the Norwegian Campaign, the crippling of Bismarck, the gallant sortie against Scharnhorst and Gneisenau as they passed through the Channel, air attacks on enemy E-boats in the narrow seas, air cover for the Russian convoys, air attacks that disabled Tirpitz, and strikes and minelaying operations against German shipping in the Norwegian littoral that continued until May 1945. By the end of the war in Europe the FAA had grown to 3243 pilots and 1336 aircraft. This book sets all these varied actions within their proper naval context and both technical and tactical aspects are explained with thumbnail descriptions of aircraft, their weapons and avionics. Cross-reference with the Fleet Air Arm Roll of Honour has been made for the first time to put names to those aircrew killed in action wherever possible as a mark of respect for their determination against enemy forces on above and below the sea surface which more often than not outnumbered them. Royal Navy Handbook 1939-1945 David Wragg, 2005-08-25 Overstretched from the start of the Second World War in 1939 the Royal Navy acquired First World War surplus destroyers from the United States Navy and embarked on a massive programme of construction building and buying aircraft carriers escort carriers and frigates and corvettes building up a powerful submarine arm and almost from scratch re creating the naval air arm taken from it in 1918 The service had to learn fast It soon became clear that the Germans would not provide an opportunity for a major battleship to battleship fleet action

along the lines of Jutland but that submarine warfare and surface raiders were to be just as effective at undermining the British war effort The Royal Navy was expected to be active in the North Atlantic and in British waters and then after the Soviet Union was invaded by Germany it had to protect the Arctic convoys Meanwhile it also had to keep control of the Mediterranean alone after the fall of France supporting ground forces in North Africa and then in Greece send convoys to Malta and disrupt the Axis supply lines both in the Mediterranean and off the coast of Norway and then it had to face the Japanese in the Far East By the war's end the Royal Navy had grown from its pre war strength of 129 000 to 863 000 men Its fleet had also grown from 12 to 61 battleships and cruisers seven to 59 aircraft carriers and 100 to 846 destroyers by 1945

British Naval Aviation in World War II Gilbert S. Guinn, G. H. Bennett, 2007-07-20 On the outcome of the Battle of the Atlantic from 1939 to 1945 depended Britain's survival in the midst of a global war The need to control the seaways to Britain was mirrored by a need to control the skies above Carrier based aircraft and seaplanes would play an important role in defeating the German submarine menace and in combating her surface fleet However at the start of World War II Britain possessed neither the training or industrial establishment necessary to develop this arm of warfare From 1940 onwards the United States provided answers to the problem firstly in the form of American built aircraft then American built aircraft carriers and finally American trained pilots Even before the Japanese attack on Pearl Harbor Royal Air Force and Fleet Air Arm pilots were being trained in the United States under a scheme set up by the United States Navy as part of the Lend Lease agreement In the safer skies over the United States American Navy pilots would train British aviation cadets how to fly and to fight This process is examined from a variety of different perspectives including the military diplomatic educational and cultural For many young British aviation cadets the journey across the Atlantic and across America was as surprising as it was lengthy Many would find themselves caught up with issues such as segregation in the American South of which they had little understanding The book is based on interviews and correspondence with hundreds of former cadets who trained in the United States in the 1940s together with material from the British and American archives

in other theaters The Soviet claim determinedly promoted through the Cold War that aid was marginal still influences attitudes in Vladimir Putin's Russia and contemporary Western opinion It even resonates through the present war in Ukraine Andrew Boyd demonstrates that in reality Western aid through the Arctic was a critical multiplier of Soviet military power throughout the war and perhaps even enabled Russia's very survival in 1942 and he makes plain that the British contribution to the aid effort was greater than generally acknowledged The book also emphasises that the Arctic conflict was not framed solely by the supply convoys important though they were British German and Russian operations in a theater defined by Adolph Hitler in early 1942 as the zone of destiny were shaped by other perceived opportunities and threats For instance Germany concentrated its fleet in Norway to forestall a potential British attack while attempting land offensives to cut Russia's links with its northern ports It also had vital raw materials to protect Britain explored potential operations with Russia to dislodge Germany from the Arctic coast and sever her access to important resources Elegantly written and incorporating many new perspectives on the Arctic theater this new work should find a place on the shelves of every historian scholar and enthusiast whose interests extend to the Russian dimension of the Second World War
