In the First and Second World Wars the homefront was a clear entity and location if you weren't on the frontlines you were on the homefront. But during current times of peacekeeping, peacemaking and armed interventions the notion of homefront seems to comprise only those who are in some way directly affected by the military family and friends or ex soldiers, an invisible group camouflaged by everyday jobs and activities. Editors Barb Howard and Joan Dixon have compiled an insightful collection of essays and reflections from 14 writers including Melanie Murray, Scott Waters, Ryan Flavelle and Chris Turner. All have found themselves at one time or another embedded on the homefront. And even though each experience is unique and comes from a single perspective, common motifs surface: family, fate, death and memory. This anthology captures triumphs, incredible fortitude and humour often in the face of grief, as well as the complicated logic, fears, anger and other everyday realities that are part of homefront life.

Coastal Lives Maximilian Viatori, Héctor Andrés Bombiella Medina, 2019-04-02 Peru's fisheries are in crisis as overfishing and ecological changes produce dramatic fluctuations in fish stocks. To address this crisis, government officials have claimed that fishers need to become responsible producers who create economic advantages by taking better care of the ocean ecologies they exploit. In *Coastal Lives*, Maximilian Viatori and Héctor Bombiella argue that this has not made Peru's fisheries more sustainable. Through a fine-grained ethnographic and historical account of Lima's fisheries, the authors reveal that new government regimes of entrepreneurial agency have placed overwhelming burdens on the city's impoverished artisanal fishers to demonstrate that they are responsible producers and have created failures that can be used to justify closing these fishers' traditional use areas and to deny their historically sanctioned rights. The result is a critical examination of how neoliberalized visions of nature and individual responsibility work to normalize the dispossessions that have enabled ongoing capital accumulation at the cost of growing social dislocations and ecological degradation. The authors' innovative approach to the politics of constructing and degrading coastal lives will interest a wide range of scholars in cultural anthropology, environmental humanities and Latin American studies, as well as policymakers and anyone concerned with inequality, global food systems and multispecies ecologies.

The Fishermen's Frontier David F. Arnold, 2009-11-17 In *The Fishermen's Frontier*, David Arnold examines the economic, social, cultural and political context in which salmon have been harvested in southeast Alaska over the past 250 years. He starts with the aboriginal fishery in which Native fishers lived in close connection with salmon ecosystems and developed rituals and lifeways that reflected their intimacy. The transformation of the salmon fishery in southeastern Alaska from an aboriginal resource to an industrial commodity has been fraught with historical ironies. Tribal peoples usually considered egalitarian and communal in nature managed their fisheries with a strict notion of property rights, while Euro-Americans so vested in the notion of property and ownership established a common property fishery when they arrived in the

late nineteenth century In the twentieth century federal conservation officials tried to rationalize the fishery by improving upon nature and promoting economic efficiency but their uncritical embrace of scientific planning and their disregard for local knowledge degraded salmon habitat and encouraged a backlash from small boat fishermen who clung to their irrational ways Meanwhile Indian and white commercial fishermen engaged in identical labors but established vastly different work cultures and identities based on competing notions of work and nature Arnold concludes with a sobering analysis of the threats to present day fishing cultures by forces beyond their control However the salmon fishery in southeastern Alaska is still very much alive entangling salmon fishermen industrialists scientists and consumers in a living web of biological and human activity that has continued for thousands of years [Kindness and the Good Society](#) William S. Strange New Country

Geoff Meggs, 2018-04-21 Salmon gillnetting in the turbulent waters of the Fraser River at the turn of the last century was dangerous back breaking work Skiffs were equipped with a single sail but most maneuvering had to be accomplished by oars an almost impossible task against any current or tide Once towed to the grounds by a cannery tug the fishermen were on their own for at least twelve hours casting their 400 metre long nets out and pulling them back by hand Their only shelter was a partial tent over the bow Many came to grief on dark windy nights as they blew out of the main channel to the mudflats of the estuary or worse the open waters of the Strait of Georgia When the powerful Fraser River Cannery Association fixed the maximum price per salmon at 15 cents fishermen united in their determination to win a decent living Their strike shut down British Columbia's second largest export industry and effectively resulted in the imposition of martial law as the cannery frustrated by political deadlock in Victoria called out the militia without government assent to achieve their ends The strike has long been understood as a watershed moment in the province's industrial history In this revealing chronicle Geoff Meggs shows it was even more than that Other strikes in that era may have lasted longer many were more violent but none drew such diverse groups Indigenous Japanese white into an uneasy short term but effective coalition While united by the common goal of economic equality strikers were divided by forceful social pressures First Nations fishermen wished to assert their Indigenous rights Japanese fishermen having fled poverty in their homeland were seeking equality and opportunity in a new country white fishermen were angered by the greed of the tiny clique of wealthy Vancouver industrialists who controlled
