Effluent America Martin V. Melosi, 2001-09-02 What is the difference between an anthill and a city? Protection from weather and predators, living and working quarters, transportation networks, food storage capability—all these they hold in common. And while there are obvious differences between humans and ants, both exist in the same space and time dimension in nature. This simple idea, imagining cities as part of the larger physical world, has driven the work of the historian Martin Melosi for twenty-five years. Melosi is one of a handful of scholars who examine urban history from an ecological perspective, using the city to help define the place of nature in human life. Cities, he maintains, are places where humans live, work, play, consume goods, and make waste, just as humans have in caves, on farms, and in villages. To imagine the city as outside of nature limits what can be known about our past and our future. *Effluent America* is a collection of essays spanning this innovative scholar's career and the growing field of urban environmental history. Garbage, wastewater, hazardous waste—these are the lenses through which Melosi views nineteenth and twentieth-century America. In broad overviews and specific case studies, *Effluent America* treats the relationship between industrial expansion and urban growth from an ecological perspective. He charts the development of city services, the rationale for their implementation, and how they affected growth. He explores the environmental impacts of unprecedented methods of production, the influence of new forms of energy, and changing patterns of consumption during the Industrial Revolution and beyond. In so doing, he traces how one of the richest nations in the world became also the most wasteful, a juxtaposition of affluence and effluence. Other essays consider the important role of American cities in the history of the conservation and environmental movements. Melosi sketches the reforms and reformers born out of such urban quality-of-life issues as pollution, sanitation, public health, and the need for greenspace. He also profiles the environmental justice movement, whose response to environmental problems is a question: Who bears the most risk? Urban environmental history is a window on the past, but it also directly informs issues of the present: public health, pollution, the role of government in delivering services, etc. *Effluent America* is an important volume for students of history and urban affairs, as well as for policymakers and all those concerned about the one world we inhabit.

Environment and Pollution in Colonial India Janine Wilhelm, 2016-04-28 India is facing a river pollution crisis today The origins of this crisis are commonly traced back to post Independence economic development and urbanisation This book in contrast shows that some important early roots of India's river pollution problem and in particular the pollution of the Ganges lie with British colonial policies on wastewater disposal during the late 19th and early 20th centuries Analysing the two cornerstones of colonial river pollution history during the late 19th and early 20th centuries the introduction of sewerage systems and the introduction of biological sewage treatment technologies in cities along the Ganges the author examines different controversies around the proposed and actual discharge of untreated treated sewage into the Ganges which involved officials on different administrative levels as well as the Indian public The analysis shows that the colonial state essentially ignored the problematic aspects of sewage disposal into rivers which were clearly evident from European experience Guided by colonial ideology and fiscal policy colonial officials supported the introduction of the cheapest available sewerage technologies which were technologies causing extensive pollution Thus policies on sewage disposal into the Ganges and other Indian rivers took on a definite shape around the turn of the 20th century and acquired certain enduring features that were to exert great negative influence on the future development of river pollution in India A well researched study on colonial river pollution history this book presents an innovative contribution to South Asian environmental history It is of

interest to scholars working on colonial South Asian and environmental history and the colonial history of public health science and technology

A Cultural History of Waste Disposal Benjamin A.
