Eventually, the rich were deemed useful when they used their wealth to help their communities in times of crisis. Yet in the twenty first century, Alfani points out, the rich and the super rich, their wealth largely preserved through the Great Recession and COVID 19, have been exceptionally reluctant to contribute to the common good in times of crisis, rejecting even such stopgap measures as temporary tax increases. History suggests that this is a troubling development for the rich and for everyone else.
