Family Systems Therapy

What is Family Systems Therapy?

A family systems perspective holds that individuals are best understood through assessing the interactions between and among family members. The development and behavior of one family member is inextricably interconnected with others in the family. The main focus of family therapy is on here-and-new interactions in the family system. One way in which family therapy differs from many individual therapies is its emphasis on how current family relationships contribute to the development and maintenance of symptoms.

This perspective is grounded on the assumptions that a client's problematic behavior may:

- (1) serve a function or purpose for the family:
- (2) be unintentionally maintained by family processes:
- (3) Be a function of the family's inability to operate productively, especially during developmental transitions; or
- (4) be a symptom of dysfunctional patterns handed down across generations. All these assumptions challenge the more traditional intrapsychic trameworks for conceptualising human problems and their formation.

Process of Family Therapy

- 1. Forming a Relationship
- 2. Conducting an Assessment
- Hypothesizing and Sharing Meaning

Focus on obtaining on occurate diagnosis perhaps using the DSM-5 (American Psychiatric Association, 2013)

Focus on the courses, purposes, and cognitive, emotional, and behavioral processes involved in Ann's depression and coping

Se concerned with Ann's individual experiences and perspectives Systemic Therapeutic Approach

Explore the system for family process and rules, perhaps using a genogram.

Focus on the family relationships within which the continuation of Ann's depression "mokes sense"
