The Frontiers of Baluchistan George Passman Tate,1909 George Passman Tate was an assistant superintendent employed by the Survey of India who headed the surveys undertaken by two missions that determined large parts of the borders of Afghanistan the Baluch Afghan Boundary Commission of 1895 96 and the Seistan Arbitration Mission of 1903 5 The first of these surveys was carried out to delimit the so called Durand Line the border between Afghanistan and British India present
